




PRINCIPLE 1: Influence is not from Your Position; it is from Your Disposition

Influence is an inside job that has nothing to do with your outward position







Root word of influence: in-("in-") + fluō ("How").







You will never behave in a way that you first do not believe










PRINCIPLE 2: Never Let Others Define You


People would rather drag you down to their level than try to rise to yours





Never let anybody convince you that you are anything different than who God made you to be



Never allow the words of a critic become louder than the cause














PRINCIPLE 4: The Experiences of Your Past Have Prepared You




PRINCIPLE 5: Stay in Your Sweet Spot



You are an original, not a cheap copy of something that already exists







