

What is “Prophecy”?


**The most common

to flow forth**






1 CORINTHIANS 14:3

another”**



**Just as speaking in tongues
is a supernatural utterance
in an unknown tongue – so
prophecy is a supernatural
utterance in a known tongue**

1 CORINTHIANS 12:7



gave gifts to men."










**Prophecy is greater than
tongues when not
accompanied by
Interpretation of
Tongues**

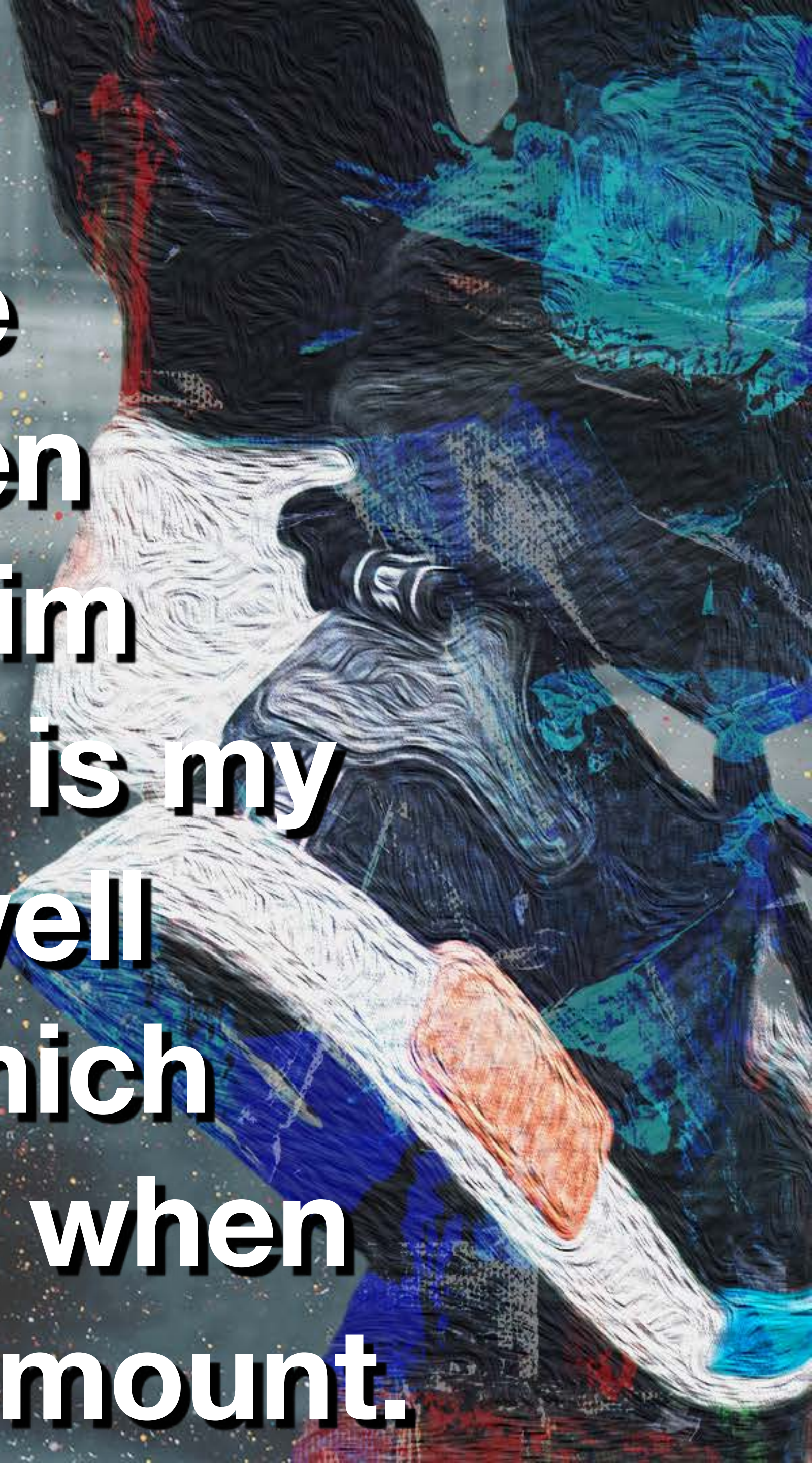
