




Even the best of pursuits done with the wrong motive will leave us empty and wanting more







PRINCIPLE 1: Pursue Spiritual Excellence

Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this [is] the whole [duty] of man.






JAMES 4:13-15






PRINCIPLE 4: Pursue a Bodily Balance
