

What is the Gift of Speaking in Other



It is the supernatural utterance by the Holy Spirit in a language never learned by the speaker - not understood by the mind of the speaker nearly always not understood by inose who hear



1CORINTHIANS 125 Now I want you all to speak in tongues, but even more to prophesy. The one who prophesies is greater than the one who speaks in tongues, unless someone interprets, so that the church may be built up.



And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues



What is the Purpose of the Gift of Speaking with Tongues?







1 CORNTHIANS 1472 For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to (ST men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.







1 CORINTHIANS 14 C He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church






EPHESIANS 518-19 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;

Speaking with Other Tongues Allows Our Spirit to Pray Distinct from our Understanding





For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my understanding is



RUMANS 825-27 Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.



RUMANS 826-27 Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.



FORNTHANS 210-11 But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God.




Speaking with Tongues Along with the Interpretation of Jongues Brings Edification to the Church



TERRITHANS 1425 How is it then, brethren? Whenever vou come together, each of you has a psalm, has a teaching, has a tongue, has a revelation, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.

ICORNTHIANS 14:33, 40 For God is not a God of confusion but of peace. But all things should be done decently and in order








IEDRINTHIANS 14:30,32 If a revelation is made to another sitting there, let the first be silent. And the spirits of the prophets are subject to the prophets.

The Gift of Tongues Must Edify the Body



However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you.



1 CORNTHANS 14 12 17 Even so you, since you are zealous for spiritual gifts, let it be for the edification of the church that you seek to excel Therefore let him who speaks in a tongue pray that he may interpret. For if I pray in a tongue, my spirit prays, but my understanding is unfruitful. What is the conclusion then?




1 CORNTHANS 14 12 17 I will pray with the spirit, and I will also pray with the understanding. I will sing with the spirit, and I will also sing with the understanding.



1 CORNTHANS 1412-17 Otherwise, if you bless with the spirit, how will he who occupies the place of the uninformed say "Amen" at your giving of thanks, since he does not understand what you say? For you indeed give thanks well, but the other is not edified.





REJUATION B Must Not Forbid Speaking in other longues





TERNITHANS 1439 So, my brothers, earnestly desire to prophesy, and do not forbid speaking in iongues.



Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, 'Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." Now this he said about the Spirit whom those who believed in him were to receive, for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.






A Message in Other **Tongues Must Have an** Interpretation



IEDRINIFIANS 14:27-28, 33 If any speak in a tongue, let there be only two or at most three, and each in turn, and let someone interpret. But if there is no one to interpret, let each of them keep silent in church and speak to himself and to God






