will not define my life.**

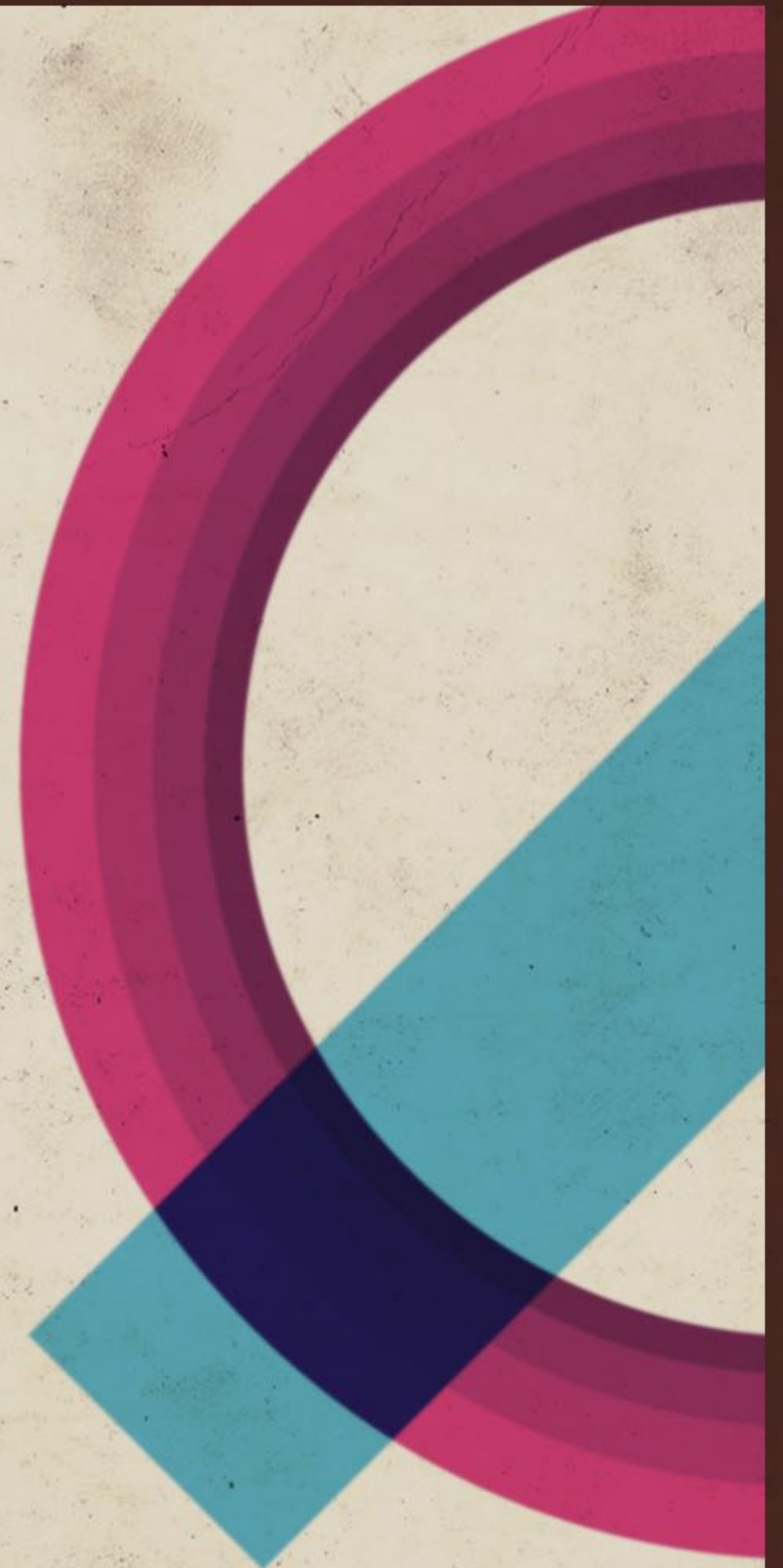





GENESIS 37:7, 9

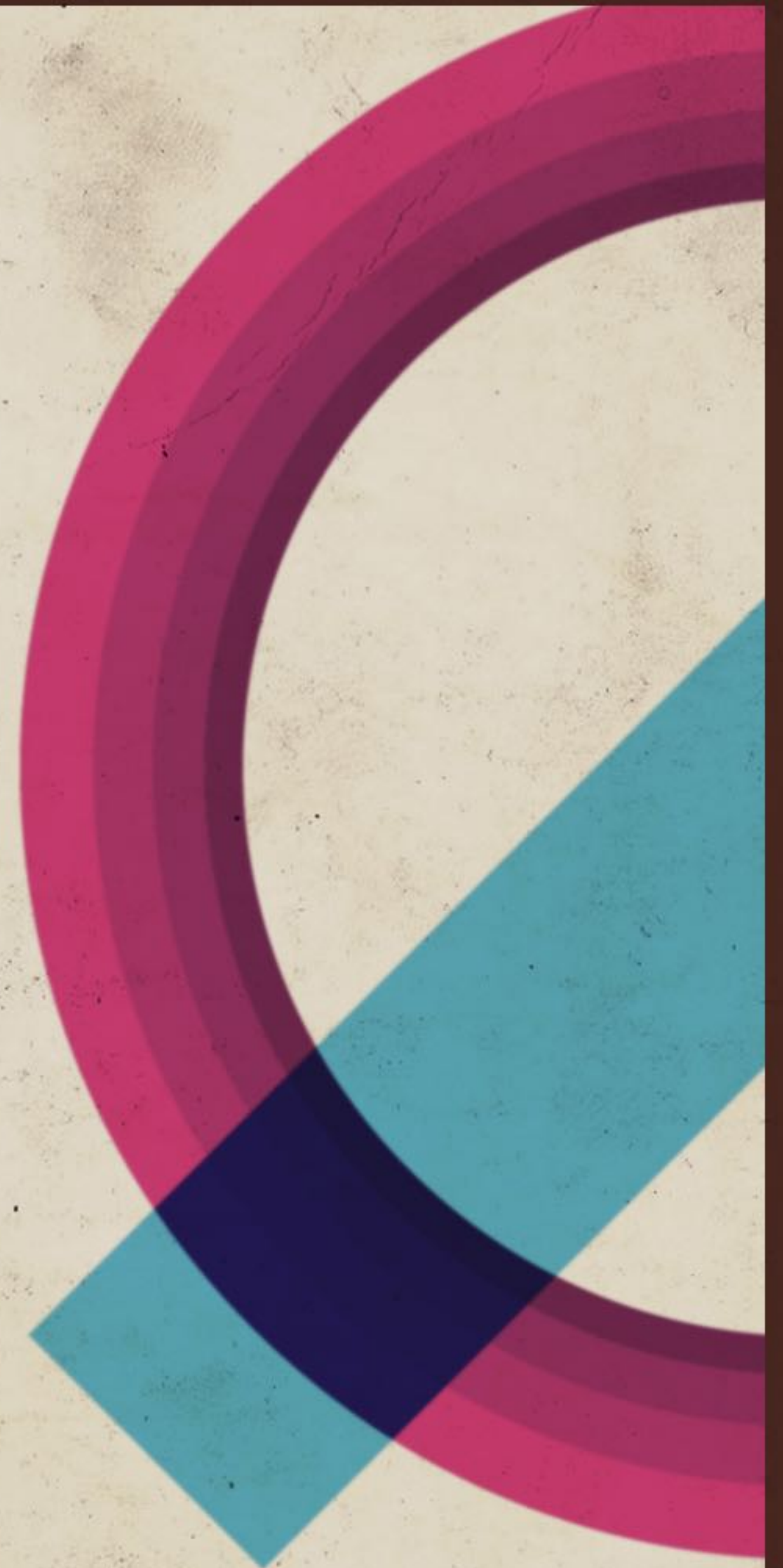


GENESIS 37:26-28

his Egyptian master.**



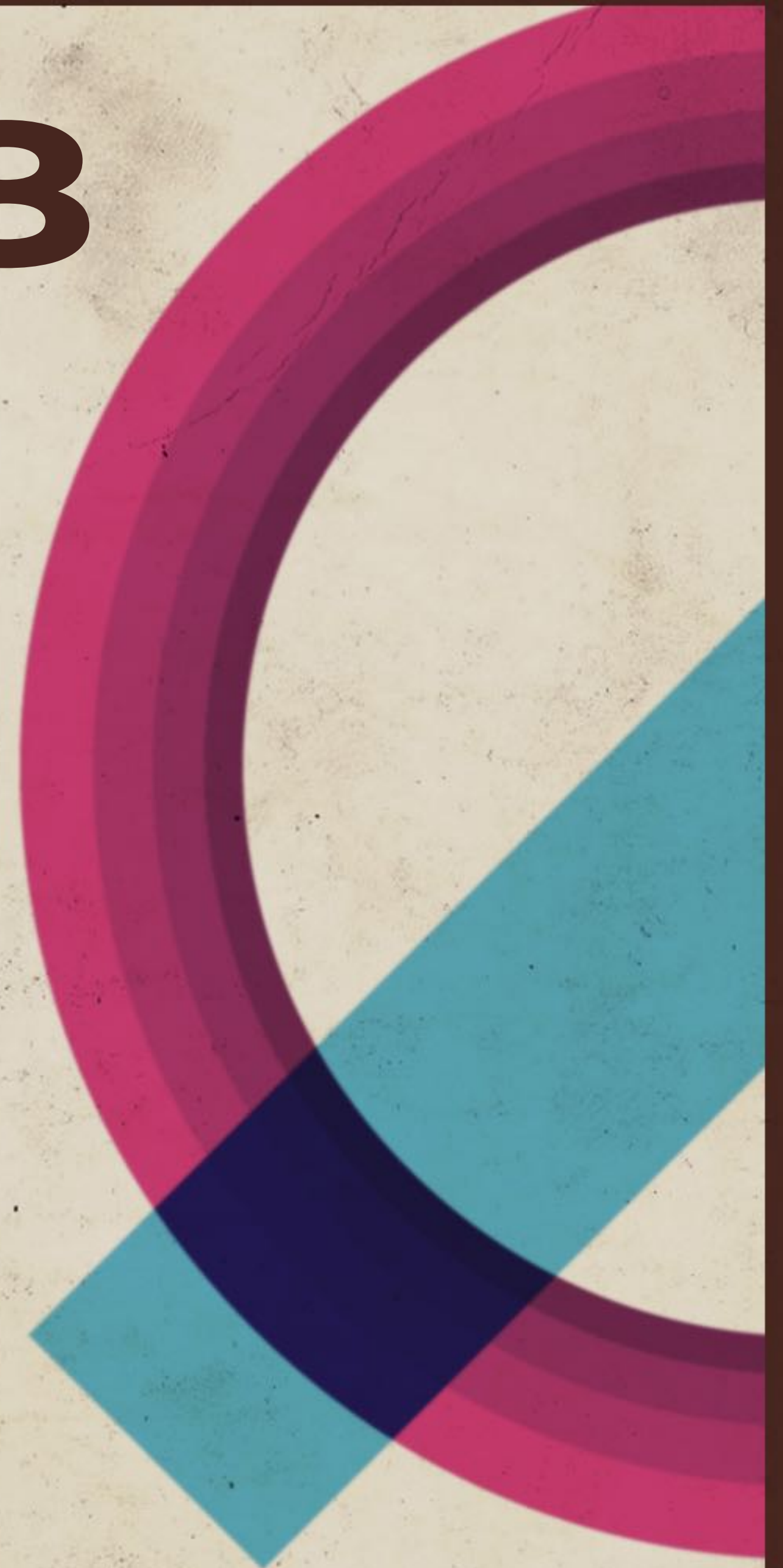


GENESIS 39:4-5

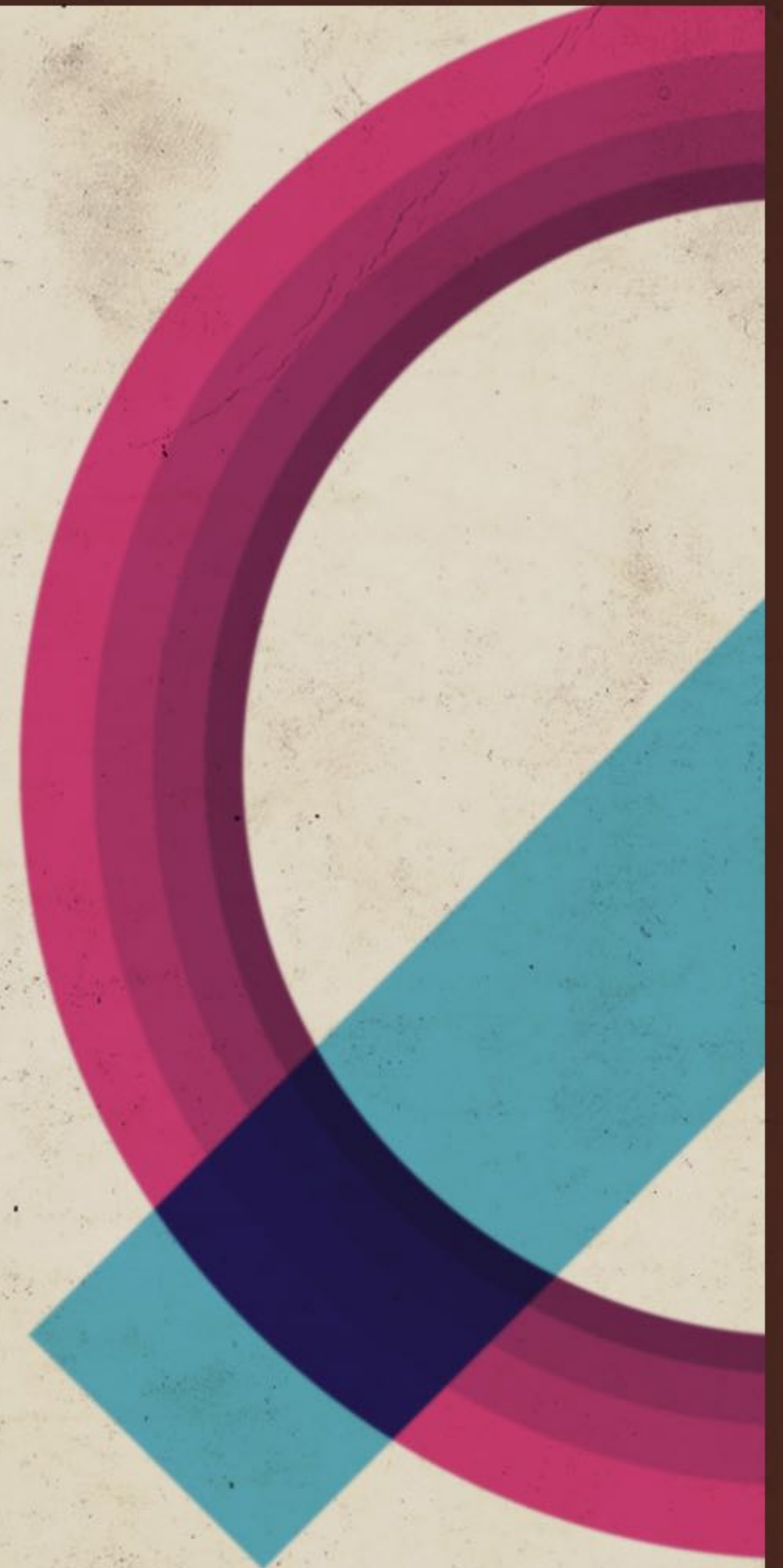




GENESIS 45:5-7

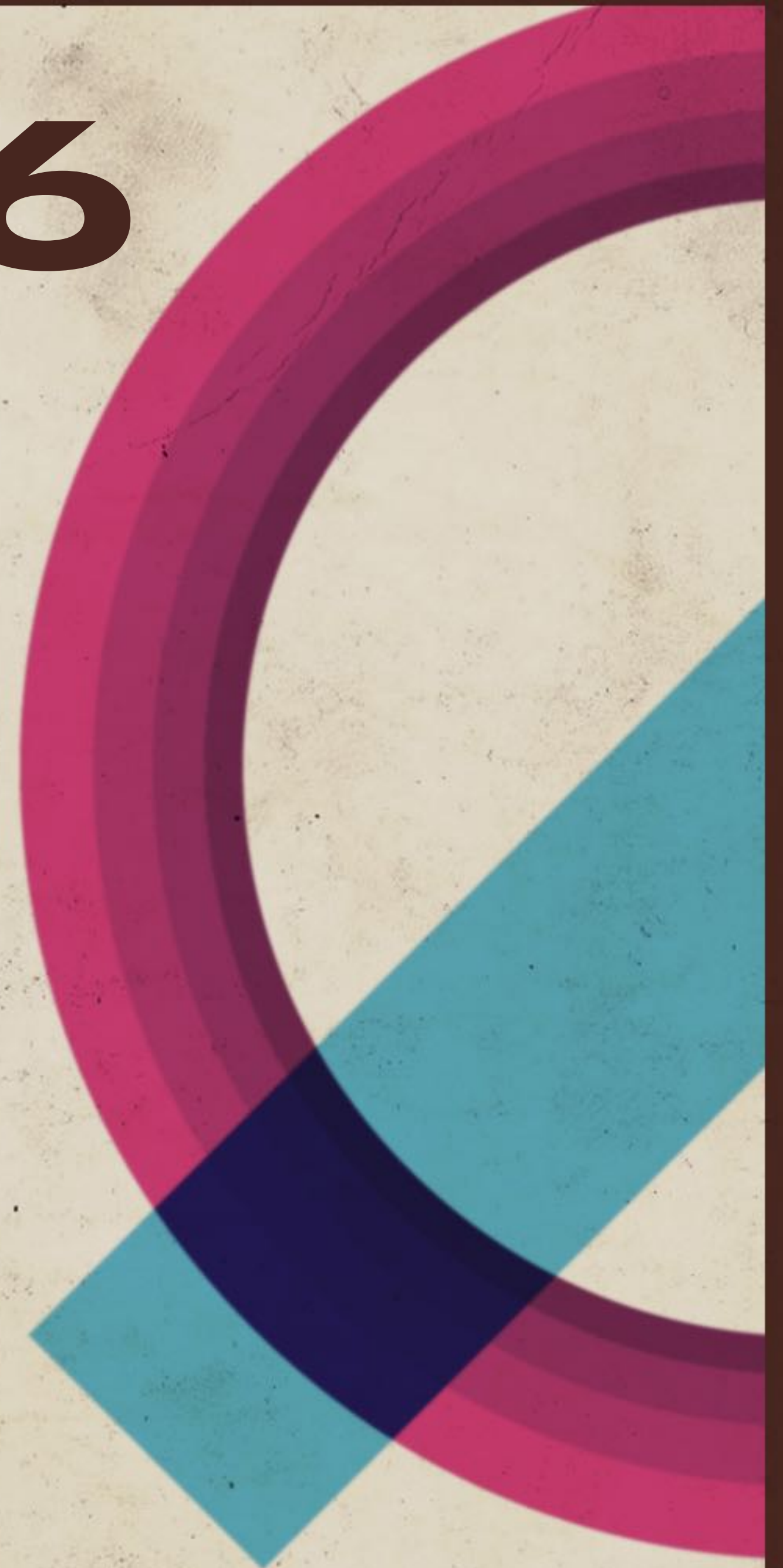
