TEACHING

TESTIMONY - Jesus is Bigger

Share as their parent an experience of how knowing deep in their heart how big/above it all Jesus has helped/is still helping them when they were scared/worried about something. Try make it as tangible as possible and perhaps a story from when you were younger to help relate.

BIBLE VERSE PUZZLES

<u>Print and cut these up for them to sort</u> and read out on different verses of how big and above it all Jesus is.

Finish by sharing that just like Jesus responded to the disciples when they asked for help, Jesus is close and hears us too. How amazing to have this kind of God, powerful, big and above everything but close and loving!



PRAYER EXERCISE

THE LORD'S PRAYER - Hallowed be your name

Remind them we are looking at HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME and explain that is means to make special, to set apart. To say Hallowed be your Name is to say, 'God there is no one else like you!' Show them our words for it.

THE LORD'S PRAYER - HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME

Put out the <u>different names for God in the middle</u> and ask the kids to pick ONE that is standing out to them and use it and the P.R.A.Y (Pause, rejoice, ask, yes) framework for prayer we used last year. You can use this as a prompt for the groups.

For eg, Say they pick 'Prince of Peace'
P - Do a breath prayer with name Lord's prayer.
Prince of Peace, hallowed be your name (or the line you came up with as a POD)

R - Thank God for being that Thank you Jesus for being Prince of Peace for me

A - Ask Him to be that in an area of life or world Jesus will you be Prince of Peace over me at school when I'm bullied.

Y- Say yes to Jesus by declaring who He is I believe you are You are Prince of Peace. Amen
