#### **ACTionS Week 5: Divine Appointments**

Text: Acts 8-9

#### I. Introduction

- The cost of preaching the truth: Stephen's martyrdom (Acts 8:1-3).
- Persecution spreads the gospel beyond Jerusalem.
- Divine appointments shape the future of the church.

### II. Divine Appointment #1 - Philip and Simon the Sorcerer (Acts 8:4-25)

- Philip in Samaria: Preaching to a mixed, spiritually chaotic people.
- Signs and wonders: Demons cast out, the lame walk, and great joy follows (Acts 8:8).
- Simon the Sorcerer: Amazed by God's power, he believes and is baptized (Acts 8:13).
- **Lesson:** The power of God is greater than any worldly magic or deception.
- Warning: Simon's desire for power leads to correction (Acts 8:22).

# III. Divine Appointment #2 - Philip and the Ethiopian Eunuch (Acts 8:26-40)

- The Spirit's Guidance: Philip is directed to a chariot in the desert (Acts 8:29-30).
- The Eunuch's Hunger for Truth: Reading Isaiah but lacking understanding.
- Philip Explains the Gospel: Jesus is the fulfillment of prophecy.

- Immediate Response: The eunuch believes and is baptized (Acts 8:36-37).
- Lesson: The Holy Spirit leads us to people prepared for salvation.

#### IV. Divine Appointment #3 – Saul's Conversion (Acts 9:1-9)

- Saul's Mission of Persecution: Seeking to imprison believers (Acts 9:1).
- A Sudden Encounter with Jesus: A blinding light and divine confrontation (Acts 9:4).
- Three Days of Darkness: Time to reflect on his past and recognize the truth (Acts 9:8-9).
- Lesson: Even the most resistant hearts can be transformed by a divine encounter.

### V. Divine Appointment #4 - Ananias and Saul (Acts 9:10-18)

- Ananias' Fear and Obedience: Called to minister to his enemy (Acts 9:10).
- Saul's Healing and Baptism: Scales fall from his eyes, he receives the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:17-18).
- **Lesson:** God uses obedient believers to restore the broken.

#### VI. The Results of Divine Appointments (Acts 9:31)

- The Church Multiplies: Persecution led to expansion.
- Peace and Growth: Walking in the fear of the Lord and the comfort of the Holy Spirit.
- Fulfillment of Acts 1:8: The gospel spreads from Jerusalem to Judea, Samaria, and beyond.

## VII. Application – Recognizing Our Divine Appointments

- 1. Be Open to the Holy Spirit's Leading (Philip followed God's direction).
- 2. Be Ready to Share the Gospel (Philip and the Ethiopian Eunuch).
- 3. Trust God to Transform Hearts (Saul's radical conversion).
- 4. Obey Even When It's Hard (Ananias overcoming fear to help Saul).

#### VIII. Conclusion

- Every believer has divine appointments waiting for them.
- Ask God to open your eyes to opportunities for repentance, prayer, restoration, and partnership.
- Challenge: Will you say, "Here I am, Lord" like Ananias?
