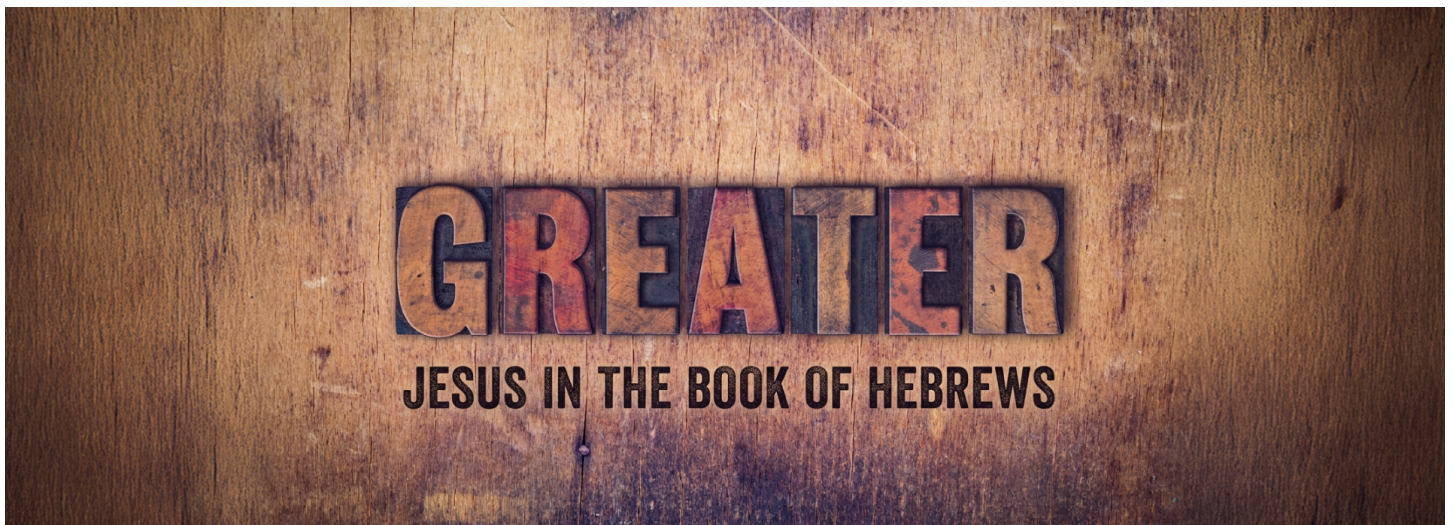




GREATER: JESUS IN THE BOOK OF HEBREWS

Hebrews 11-13

Key Truth

The message of Hebrews is not that we become greater. It is that in Jesus we have been given something greater.

Throughout Hebrews we have seen:

- Jesus is greater than the prophets
- Jesus is greater than the angels
- Jesus is greater than Moses
- Jesus is greater than the old covenant
- Jesus is our greater High Priest
- Jesus offered a greater sacrifice
- Jesus established a better covenant

I. GREATER FAITH

Hebrews 11

Faith trusts God before it sees.

Hebrews 11:1

1. Faith requires **obedience before evidence**.
2. Faith obeys when God doesn't explain everything.
3. Faith remains even when the answer doesn't come.

Faith is not trusting God for my preferred outcome.

Faith is trusting God regardless of the outcome.

II. GREATER DISCIPLINE

Hebrews 12:1-17

1. **Lay aside** what weighs you down.
2. **Run with endurance** the race God has set before you.
3. **Fix your eyes on Jesus**.
4. God's discipline produces something greater.

God is more interested in who you're becoming than what you're getting.

III. GREATER CELEBRATION

Hebrews 12:18-29; Hebrews 13

1. We have come to something greater.
2. We have received an **unshakable Kingdom**.
3. Celebration produces gratitude.
4. Celebration becomes a lifestyle.

I praise God because of who He is, not merely because of what He's done lately.

THE GREATER JESUS

Hebrews 13:8

"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever."

Because Jesus is greater:

- We can have greater faith.
- We can live with greater discipline.
- We can experience greater celebration.
