# **Fear Not**

#### Introduction

- Acknowledge the season: Fall, Halloween decorations, horror movies, cultural focus on fear.
- Stats:
  - $\circ~\$900M$  on decorations in 2005  $\rightarrow$  \$5B today.
  - \$13B total on Halloween festivities annually.
  - Horror = ~1 in 10 movies released.
- Clarify: Not a "Halloween rant," but a focus on how fear grips our lives all year long.

#### Fear in Our Culture

- Fear doesn't appear for just a few weeks; it lingers and paralyzes spiritually, mentally, physically.
- Top 10 fears (psychology research): death, public speaking, failure, rejection, loneliness, dark, heights, confined spaces, illness/pain, unknown.
- Honesty: Most of us resonated with at least one fear on this list.
- Analogy: Mario Bros. "micro-goombas" → fear slows us down, keeps us from jumping forward in faith.

### Fear in the Bible: Abram's Story

## 1. Leaving Home (Gen 12)

- Abram leaves Haran after Terah's death.
- God directs him to Canaan.
- Builds altars, worships.

## 2. Famine & Egypt (Gen 12:10-20)

- $\circ \ \ \text{Fear of losing his life} \rightarrow \text{lies about Sarai}.$
- o Pharaoh takes her; plagues fall.
- o Abram leaves wealthier, foreshadowing God's protection of His bride.

# 3. Conflict with Lot (Gen 13)

- o Fear of losing relationship/land.
- Lot chooses fertile land.
- o God responds with promise of descendants and inheritance.

# 4. War & Rescue (Gen 14)

- Abram rescues Lot from captivity.
- Honors God with tithe to Melchizedek.

### 5. God's Direct Word (Gen 15:1)

- "Do not be afraid, Abram, for I will protect you, and your reward will be great."
- Abram voices fears: no son, no proof of inheritance.
- God confirms covenant with dramatic vision: terror and darkness → torch and fire pot seal His promise.

#### Fear in Isaac's Story

### 1. Famine & New Land (Gen 26)

- Like his father, lies about wife Rebekah being his sister.
- o King Abimelek discovers truth.
- God protects covenant line.

# 2. Blessing & Opposition (Gen 26:12–22)

- Isaac prospers but faces hostility: wells filled in, enemies chase him out.
- Ongoing sabotage and conflict.

# 3. God's Word Again (Gen 26:24)

- o "Do not be afraid, for I am with you and will bless you."
- Same reassurance given to Abraham.

# 4. Response & Testimony (Gen 26:25–29)

- o Isaac builds altar, worships, digs well.
- o Even enemies recognize God's blessing.

#### The Pattern

- Fear of losing life, family, land, or security.
- God's response is consistent: Do not be afraid, I am with you.
- His presence and promises outweigh fear's grip.

### **Application**

- What fear clings to you right now?
  - o Losing something you love?
  - Others sabotaging your work?
  - o Facing the unknown?
- God's covenant words: Do not be afraid, I am with you.
- Like Abram and Isaac, we worship and trust God in the middle of fear.

## **Takeaway**

- Fear is real, but so is God's presence.
- His word to you: Do not be afraid. I am with you.
- Action step: Every time fear rises this week, declare:
  - o "Do not be afraid, the Lord is with me."
