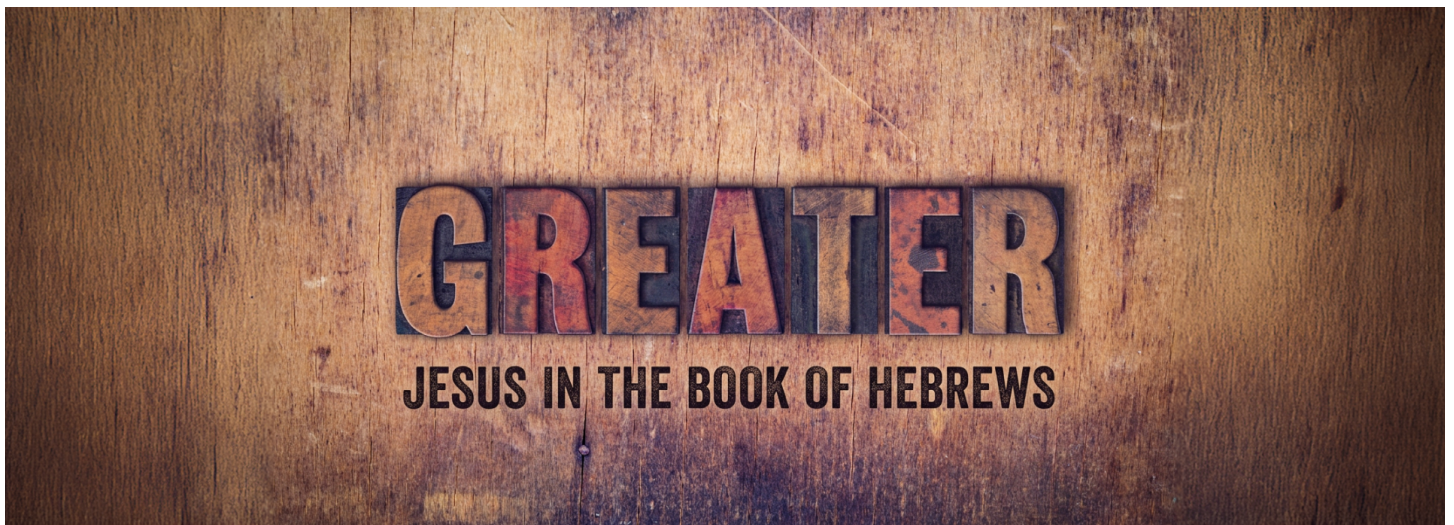




# GREATER: JESUS IN THE BOOK OF HEBREWS

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## Greater Week 2 - The Builder

Jesus is greater than Moses because He is the Builder of God's house. Through faith in Him we enter God's rest, but unbelief hardens the heart and keeps us from His promise.

### Main Scripture

Hebrews 3:1-19; Hebrews 4:1-13

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### I. Greater Than Moses

#### He is the Builder

- Moses was faithful **in** God's house.
- Jesus is faithful **over** God's house.
- We are God's house, and Christ is the Son over it.

**Scripture:** Hebrews 3:1-6; Hebrews 1:10

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## II. The Danger of a Hard Heart

- "Today" is the day to respond to God's voice.
- Unbelief keeps people from God's promises.
- We must exhort and encourage one another daily.
- Faith was never meant to be lived alone.

**Scripture:** Hebrews 3:7-19; Psalm 95:7-8

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## III. More Than Relief

- God's rest is more than physical rest.
- God's promise of rest still stands today.
- The rest found in Christ is the fulfillment of the Promised Land.

**Scripture:** Hebrews 4:1-11; Isaiah 40:31

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## IV. Not About Performance

- God's Word exposes the true condition of our hearts.
- Nothing is hidden from God.
- The answer is not self-improvement, but faith in Christ.

**Scripture:** Hebrews 4:12-13
