

Week 7 – Letters to the Thessalonians

Outline: Persecution, Lawlessness, and Hope

1. Persecution is Nothing New

- Definition: to harass or punish for differences (religion, origin, outlook).
- Paul writes to Thessalonians about persecution (2 Thess. 1:5–6).
- Modern reminders (9/11 and recent tragedies).
- We are created in the image of God (Gen. 2).

2. The Hope of His Return

- Gathering together in worship → anticipating the final gathering (2 Thess. 2:1).
- Danger of impatience and selfish prayers for His return.
- The call to meditate on Christ's return with reverence, not escapism.

3. Don't Be Deceived (2 Thess. 2:2-3)

- False reports of Christ's return already happening.
- A great rebellion will come first, then the "man of lawlessness."
- Historic speculations:
 - Roman emperors (Nero, Domitian, Diocletian).
 - o Religious figures (Muhammad, the papacy).
 - Modern leaders (Hitler, Stalin, Mao, Saddam).
- Modern temptation: to speculate about current figures → instead, stay watchful and discerning.

4. The Restraint (2 Thess. 2:6–7)

- Evil is already at work, but restrained.
- Holy Spirit at work in the church is the true restraint.
- Even in tragedy, God works for good (Gen. 50:20).

5. The Lawless One vs. The Returning King

- The Antichrist will not just oppose Christ, but attempt to replace Him.
- Many candidates in history, but only one will fulfill God's timing.
- Jesus will slay him with the breath of His mouth (2 Thess. 2:8).
- Revelation 19:11–16 → Christ returns as King of kings and Lord of lords.
- Physical restoration, spiritual vindication, eternal victory.

6. Be Prudent, Not Deceived

- Warning: false miracles and enjoyment of evil (2 Thess. 2:9–12).
- Response: Stand firm and hold on to sound teaching (2 Thess. 2:15–17).
- Our focus is not on the Antichrist but on Christ.
- Mission: Share the hope of Christ's return with others.
