The Book of Esther

Sermon Title: "Rising in the Midst of a Hot Mess"

Key Verse: Esther 4:14 – "...And who knows but that you have come to your royal position for such a time as this?"

I. When Life Feels Like a Hot Mess

- We all face moments of:
 - Confusion
 - Injustice
 - Pressure
 - Fear
- We ask: "Why me? Why here? Why now?"
 - Main Idea: What if God hasn't misplaced you—but strategically placed you?

II. Esther: Positioned on Purpose

- Esther didn't grow up in a palace—she grew up in exile, raised by her cousin Mordecai
- She was taken into a beauty contest she never asked for
- Made queen not by privilege, but by divine placement through pain
 - **Truth**: God doesn't wait for perfect conditions to fulfill His perfect plan.

Read: Esther 2:3-8

III. Your Mess Might Be Your Moment

- God doesn't always rescue us from the mess—
 - He positions us in it.
- Don't just survive this season—start thriving in it.
 - That job, that neighborhood, that tension—it may be your Esther moment.

IV. When Evil Rises, So Must You

- Enter the villain: Haman
 - Plot to destroy the Jews
 - Mordecai refuses to bow
- Esther is asked to speak up—but it could cost her everything

Read: Esther 4:13–16

V. Esther's 3 Big Challenges

1. **Fear** – approaching the king could mean death

- 2. Identity she had hidden who she was3. Risk she could lose it all
 - 💬 "If I perish, I perish."
 - Challenge: Let your faith be louder than your fear.

VI. Don't Move Before You Fast

- Esther didn't rush—she paused to fast and pray
- Before you speak, seek
 - Some doors only open after prayerful preparation
- Read: Esther 4:15-17

VII. Wisdom + Boldness = Breakthrough

- Esther uses both:
 - She builds relationship
 - She waits for God's timing
- On the second dinner, she exposes the truth
- **Key**: Breakthrough doesn't just come from the truth you carry, but the timing you trust.

VIII. God Turns Plots Into Platforms

- A new decree is written
- The people are saved
- Read: Esther 8:10-11
 - Reminder: Don't give up mid-story. God turns mourning into dancing!

IX. Final Challenge: What Will You Do With This Moment?

- Esther made a **choice**: courage > comfort, faith > fear
- God still uses ordinary people to do extraordinary things
 - ? Where has God positioned you?? What fear must you overcome?! Maybe THIS is your sign.
