

1 Peter 1:13 | Real hope is found in Jesus

In this first chapter, Peter has just explained that we have been born again to a living hope. It is a living hope that is imperishable, undefiled and unfading, a hope kept in heaven for you. While we don't see Jesus right now, we can believe in him and rejoice with joy that we will obtain the salvation he promised. We live with this hope.

Therefore, preparing your minds for action, and being sober-minded, set your hope fully on the grace that will be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ.
