
## MY NEXT STEP TODAY IS TO ...





#### **Learning To Pray**

♥ Prayer is Beautiful. Powerful. A Privilege like no other.

#### Luke 11 $\sim$ The Disciples Were Watching & Listening To <u>JESUS</u> Pray In A Certain Place.

- ✤ Jesus was accustomed to praying often, in different places and at various times.
- № v.1 ~ Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, that one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples."
- ♥ vv.2-4 ~ <sup>2</sup> So He said to them, "When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. <sup>3</sup> Give us day by day our daily bread. <sup>4</sup> And forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one."

# <u>Message Talk Sheet (Continued...)</u>

#### 1. Jesus First Speaks of A Man In CRISIS.

- ✤ Mark 16:17-18 ~ These signs will follow them who believe...
- ▶ vv.5-7 ~ The crisis was the burden of HOSPITALITY.
- $\blacksquare$  v.8 ~ Jesus gives us the principle of the parable:

"I say to you, though he will not rise and give to him because he is his friend, yet because of his **persistence** he will rise and give him as many as he needs."

#### 2. Jesus Next Speaks of the <u>CHILDREN</u> of God.

★ vv.9-10 ~ <sup>9</sup> "So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. <sup>10</sup> For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened."



♥ God is waiting... searching... listening...

#### 3. Jesus Closes His Teaching Speaking of The Good FATHER.

 $\blacksquare$  vv.11-13 ~ Jesus speaks of the friendship of God.

<sup>1</sup> If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? <sup>12</sup> Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? <sup>13</sup> If you then, being evil know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more will your** 



heavenly Father give <u>the Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u> to those who ask Him!"

Matthew 7:7-11 ~ Ask, <u>SEEK</u>, Knock!
