
### The Commissioning of Deacons




# "The Ministry of Deacons"

### It's All About "Serving" One Another

▶ It's not just Pastors & Deacons whom God is calling to serve one another, but all of us. So this message really applies to all of us!

#### Text: Acts 6:1-7 – Seven Chosen to Serve

- ▼ v.3 "Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you **seven men** of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business."
- ▼ v.7 "Then the word of God spread, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were obedient to the faith."




# Good Things Come As A Result of Quality Leadership and The Ministry of Deacons

№ Note Acts 6:1 and 6:7 – The Word of God spread, growth & conversion.

### The Ministry of Deacons

The need arose out of a complaint (γογγυσμός – a grumbling) ¹ – the Greek widows were being neglected in the daily distribution (v.1).



- ★ The Twelve Apostles responded addressing the critical roles of ministry within the church...
  - The Role of Apostles (aka, elders, bishops, pastors) (vv.2, 4). [See also 1 Tim. 4:1-2; 1 Peter 5:1-4; 1 Timothy 3:1]
    - > They oversee the <u>doctrine</u> of the church.
    - > They oversee the <u>direction</u> of the church.
    - They oversee the <u>depth</u> of the church. <sup>2</sup>
    - The Elder has ruling / governing authority (1 Thess. 5:12-13;
       1 Tim. 3:4-5; 5:17-18; Titus 1:5-9; Heb. 13:17; 1 Pet. 5:1-4)
  - The Role of Deacons (διακονέω to serve / "through the dirt") <sup>3</sup> (vv.3, 5). [See also Rom. 16:1; Phil. 1;1; 1 Tim. 3:8, 12-13]
    - Facilities, Benevolence, Finances, Ushers, Logistics, Serving the needs of the church body. 4
    - They address complaints.
    - > They show concern.
    - They <u>encourage</u> the leadership of the church. <sup>5</sup>



#### The Qualifications of Deacons

- ★ Acts 6:3 "Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business."
  - ♦ The Qualifications for Elders / Bishops / Pastors (1 Tim. 3:1-7).
  - ♥ The Qualifications of Deacons (1 Timothy 3:8-13).
    - Concerning Women Serving as a Deaconess See Rom. 16:1 where the term is used for **Phoebe** in the church of Cenchrea.
