

4. The Work of Our Salvation Was Completed & Finished On The Cross!

- ↪ It was foreshadowed at the Last Supper (Matthew 26:26-29).
- ↪ It was predicted in the impending denial of the disciples (vv.30-35).
- ↪ It was solidified in The Garden where Jesus committed Himself to the burden of the cross (vv.36-44).
- ↪ It was transacted in the face of His betrayer (26:45-56; 27:3-10).
- ↪ It was fortified before the Chief Priests and the Governor Pontius Pilate as Jesus revealed His resolve to be the Sacrificial Lamb (26:57-68; 27:11-26a; Isaiah 53:7; 50:6-7).
"I gave My back to those who struck Me, and My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting. ...I have set My face like a flint!"
- ↪ It was implemented in the Crucifixion (27:26b-44)!
- ↪ It was **Finished** on the Cross (Matt. 27:45-54; Mark 15:37; John 19:30)!
- ↪ Jesus had made One Sacrifice – "Once – and For All" (Heb. 10:10-14).



Come To The Cross and Be Forgiven!

- ↪ Believe on Jesus Christ and His sacrifice for your salvation (Acts 16:31).
- ↪ Confess and Repent of your sins (Romans 10:9-10).
- ↪ Call on the Name of the Lord & receive forgiveness (Romans 10:12-13).

Habakkuk 3:17-18; Matthew 26:26-56; 27:27-54

"The Savior Has Died!"

Good Friday

- ↪ A Dark & Sad Day... The weight of the cross.
- ↪ A Day of Spiritual Transaction: He, who knew no sin, was taking upon Himself our sins as His own offenses!

Four Reflective Thoughts

1. The Shepherd Savior Has Positioned Himself To Face God's Wrath for Us!

- ↪ Man was accursed – living under the wrath and judgment of God and the Law: Dead in sins and trespasses (Ephesians 2:1, 5).
- ↪ Then the Shepherd Savior came and stood in the gap! (Isaiah 59:15-19; Zechariah 13:7)

"Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, against the Man who is My Companion," Says the Lord of hosts. "Strike the Shepherd, and the sheep will be scattered."

2. The Wages of Sin is Death!

- ↪ The Ugly Reality of Death!
- ↪ The Bible declares as God's ultimate Word and Final Authority on the subject matter of sin...
 - ☆ Romans 6:23 – "The wages of sin is death!"
 - ☆ Ezekiel 18:4, 20 – "The soul who sins shall die!"
 - ☆ Isaiah 43:24 – "You have burdened Me with your sins..."
 - ☆ Isaiah 59:1-3 – "Your iniquities have separated you from your God..."
 - ☆ Romans 3:23 – "For all have sinned and come short..."
 - ☆ Isaiah 64:6-7b – "But we are all like an unclean thing..."
- ↪ Jesus took **OUR SINS** upon Himself!
 - ☆ Psalm 40:12; 38:1-22 – "My iniquities have overtaken me..."
 - ☆ He was facing the wrath of God and the judgment / punishment (penalty) of sin – which ultimately is **death**. (Matthew 27:50 / Mark 15:37 – "And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and yielded up His spirit... and breathed His last!")



3. Jesus Suffered Taking Our Sin Upon Himself!

- ↪ Selected Weekend Reading: Isaiah 42 / 52 / 53 / 63-64 / Psalm 22
 - ☆ Isaiah 52:14 – "His visage was marred more than any man..."
 - ☆ Isaiah 52:3-5 – "He was despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief... He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities."
- ↪ Jesus suffered physically, mentally, emotionally and spiritually!
 - ☆ Psalm 41:9; Zechariah 13:6; Psalm 22:1; Matthew 27:46
