


Scripture

- ✖ Which message did you find yourself most drawn to and resonating with?

A Living Hope

- ✖ Peter says God has begotten us to a living hope... (1 Peter 1:3)
- ✖ What does that mean to you? How would you choose to define "living hope" to a friend?



Scripture

- ✖ Matthew 27:35-46 – The Crucifixion of Jesus
- ✖ Consider what was happening on the cross with Jesus. How would you define God's judgment here on the sins of mankind that were taken up by Jesus? (Read 2 Corinthians 5:21 – does this help?)
- ✖ **Where Once There Was Judgment – Now There Is Salvation!** What does this statement mean to you?

Scripture

- ✖ Matthew 27:57-61; 28:1-10 – The Living Hope of Resurrection
- ✖ Consider the transition that happened between Jesus' burial and Easter Sunday Morning! How were people feeling Friday? How were people feeling Saturday? How were people feeling Sunday?)
- ✖ **Where Once There Was Death – Now There Is Life!** What does this statement mean to you?

Scripture

- ✖ John 20:11-18 – Outside the Tomb of Jesus There is Hopelessness, Sadness, Tears & Fears, Mourning & Loss! Describe how you have felt after losing a loved one to death and the subsequent feelings that follow days, weeks and months afterwards. Can you relate to the Disciples of Jesus?
- ✖ Mark 16:9-14 – Without Hope There Is Disbelief & Hardness of Heart. What happens to some who do not have hope when their loved one passes away? Have you seen people become bitter, angry, hopeless?
- ✖ Inside the Tomb Life Is Stirring, Resurrection Power, Living Hope!
- ✖ **Where Once There Was Hopelessness – Now There Is Hope!** What does this statement mean to you?

The Journey to a Living Hope!

- ✖ Read 1 Peter 1:3-21 once again. Are you on the journey to a living Hope? What verses from this passage jump out at you?
- ✖ **Where Once There Was Bankruptcy – Now There Is An Eternal Inheritance!"**
