
# 8. <u>The Extraordinary Fruit of</u> <u>GENTLENESS.</u>

Also known as... "<u>Meekness</u>" or "<u>Humility.</u>"



✤ A Definition of Gentleness ~ "prautes"

Restraint coupled with strength and courage; it describes a person who can be bold when bravery is needed and humbly submissive when resignation or surrender is needed.

- ▲ Scriptures: Romans 12:10, 16; 1 Corinthians 13:4; Isaiah 57:15; Matthew 18:4, 23:12; Colossians 3:12; 1 Timothy 6:11; 2 Timothy 2:24-25; James 3:17; 1 Peter 3:15.
- ▲ Examples: Jesus Compare Matt. 11:19 with Matt. 23; Mark 3:5
  Paul Compare 2 Cor. 10:1 with 2 Cor. 10:4-6; Gal. 1:9
  Moses Compare Numbers 12:3 with Exodus 32:19-20
- - ♦ Outbursts of Wrath ~ "thumos": (Colossians 3:8)
  - False Humility ~ "A pretense of meekness and modesty" (Colossians 2:18-23)

#### 9. <u>The Admirable Fruit</u> of <u>SELF-CONTROL</u>.




- ▲ Also known as... "<u>Temperance</u>"
- ✤ Self-control is the exercise of yielding to the power of the Spirit's desires and wishes. (James 4:5-10; Ephesians 5:15-18; Galatians 5:16-26; Rom. 8:1, 5-14)
- A Definition of Self-Control ~ "egkrateia"


Having control or mastery over one's own desires and passions, including faithfulness to one's marriage vows; also purity & chastity.

 ▲ Goodness is Righteousness in action! (James 4:17; 1 Peter 3:16-17; Matthew 7:12; Luke 6:31) [The Golden Rule]



✤ A Definition of Goodness ~ "agathosune"

Zeal for truth and righteousness and a hatred for evil (Romans 12:9, 21; 1 Cor. 13:6; Hebrews 1:9; 1 Peter 3:11; Jude 23); it can be expressed in acts of kindness (Luke 7:37-50 ~ the woman with the alabaster jar of oil) or in rebuking and correcting evil (Matt. 21:12-13 ~ the cleansing of the temple).

- ➡ Scriptures: Romans 12:13; Ephesians 2:10; 4:15, 28; James 2:14-17; Acts 11:24; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 1 Peter 3:8-17; Psalm 34:12-16; 1 Thessalonians 5:15; Colossians 3:17; Amos 5:14-15; Psalm 107:8-9, 15, 21, 31; Romans 15:14.
- ▶ The Works of the Flesh ~ The Antagonists of Goodness:
  - ✤ Heresies ~ "hairesis": (1 Corinthians 3:3-4; 11:18-19)
  - Seditions ~ "dichostasia": (Romans 16:17; Acts 15:1; 1 Tim. 4:1-3, 6-7; 6:3-5, 17-19; 2 Timothy 2:14-19, 23-26; 4:2-5)

#### 7. The Commendable Fruit of <u>FAITHFULNESS.</u>



- ✤ Faithfulness is a Commitment that one Dutifully Fulfills. (1 Corinthians 13:8)
   [Love Never Fails!]
- ▲ A Definition of Faithfulness ~ "pistis"

A firm and unswerving loyalty and adherence to a person to whom one is united by promise, commitment, trustworthiness, & honesty.

- ✤ Scriptures: 1 Cor. 1:9; 1 Thess. 5:24; 2 Thess. 3:3; Romans 3:34-;
  2 Timothy 2:13; Psalm 36:5; 89:24, 28, 30-37; Lam. 3:22-23.
- M The Works of the Flesh ~ <u>The Foes of Faithfulness:</u>
  - Idolatry ~ "eidolatria": (Ephesians 3:17-19; 4:13-16; 5:5-7; Colossians 1:23; 3:5-6)
  - Soceries (Witchcraft) ~ "pharmakeia": (Exodus 7:11, 22; 8:18; Revelation 9:20-21; 18:23)



# 9. <u>The Admirable Fruit of SELF-</u> <u>CONTROL (Continued...)</u>



- ▲ Scriptures: 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 9:24-25; 10:13; 2 Timothy 1:7; 1 Thess. 5:6-8; 1 Timothy 3:2; Titus 1:8; 2:2-6, 11-12; 1 Peter 1:13-16; 4:7; 5:7; 2 Peter 1:6. [Sober – Sober-minded = Self-Control]
- - Drunkenness ~ "methe": (Proverbs 23:29-35; Luke 21:34; Roans 13:13; Galatians 5:21; Ephesians 5:18; 1 Peter 4:3)
  - ✤ <u>Revelries</u> ~ "komos": (Romans 13:13; 1 Peter 4:1-5)
  - ✤ Lewdness ~ "aselgeia": (2 Corinthians 12:21)



### All Believers Should <u>PRODUCE the Fruit of The</u> <u>Spirit as a Direct Result of</u> <u>the Indwelling Spirit of God.</u>

- ✤ The Fruit of the Spirit is an <u>intrinsic product</u> of the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives.
- ✤ There is <u>no law</u> prohibiting the exercise and practice of these virtues (Galatians 5:18, 23).
- Seek to put off <u>the old man of flesh</u> with its passions and desires and to put on <u>the new man of the Spirit!</u> (Galatians 5:24-25; Romans 6:22).
