- ✚ The Details of the Passover are Prophetic Details (Colossians 2:16-17)

Text – The Passover Celebrated

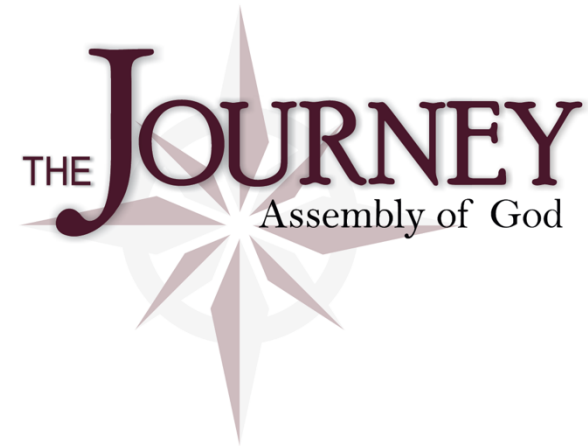
- ✚ Luke 22:1, 7-20 – ¹ “Now the Feast of Unleavened Bread drew near, **which is called Passover.**” ¹⁹ And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.” ²⁰ Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.”

#4 – The Fulfillment and Significance of the Jewish Passover Is Found In The Last Supper and Jesus’ Crucifixion!

- ✚ Jesus Instituted a New Instruction for Passover – It’s TRUE meaning!
- ✚ John the Baptist Identified Jesus as the Lamb of God (John 1:29-36)
- ✚ Jesus Spoke of His Body & His Blood as the Fulfillment of Passover!
 - ☆ Hebrews 10:5; Isaiah 53; Psalm 22; 40:6-8; Psalm 118:22; Matthew 21:42; 1 Peter 2:7; **1 Corinthians 5:7 – “For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.”** ee
- ✚ Jesus Instituted the New Covenant of God (1 Corinthians 11:25; Hebrews 9:15; 12:24; Romans 8:1-3; Ephesians 2:11-13)

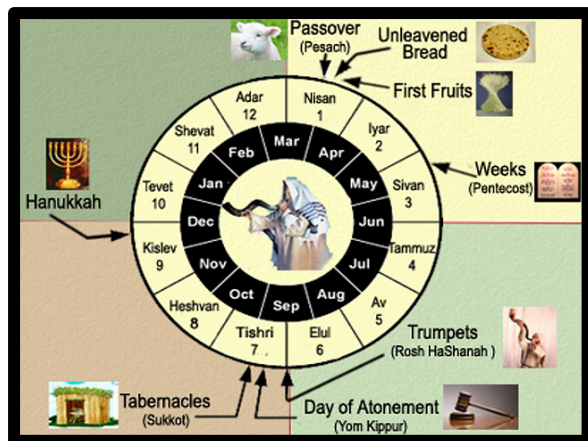

"The Feast of Passover"

Text – The Feasts of God

- ✚ Leviticus 23:1-2, 4-5 – ¹ "And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, ² 'Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'The feasts of the Lord, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, these are My feasts.' ⁴ "These are the feasts of the Lord, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times. ⁵ On the fourteenth day of the first month at twilight **is the Lord's Passover.**"



Text – The Passover Instituted

- ✚ Exodus 12:1-14 – ⁷ "And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it."

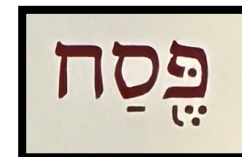


- ✚ ¹¹ "And thus you shall eat it: with a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. **It is the Lord's Passover.**"

- ✚ ¹² 'For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will **strike all the firstborn** in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the Lord. ¹³ Now the blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you are. **And when I see the blood, I will pass over you...**"

#1 – The Backdrop & Context of the Jewish Passover Is Found In Their Deliverance Out of Egypt.

- ✚ Deuteronomy 18:15-19 – A Prophet Like Moses
- ✚ The Plagues Against Egypt (Exodus 7-12)
- ✚ The Passover - Pesach (Exodus 12:11)



#2 – The Observation of the Jewish Passover Is Found In Both The Old Testament and the New Testament.

- ✚ Exodus 12:14-15 – A Feast By An Everlasting Ordinance
- ✚ The Israelites Tragically Forgot To Keep It (2 Chronicles 30:1-27; 2 Kings 22-23)
- ✚ Jesus & His Disciples Faithfully Honored The Passover (Luke 2:41-50; Matthew 26:17-19; Mark 14:12-16; Luke 22:7-20; John 2:13-22; 6:4; 11:55)
