- ✞ And let's surrender our hearts to the Lordship of Christ.

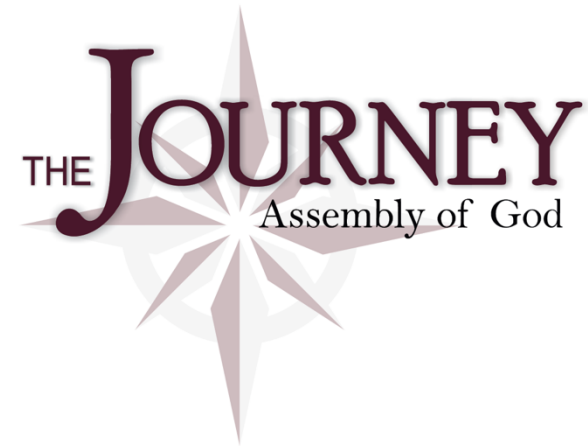
Salvation Prayer

Text: Luke 22:13-20 ~ The Passover is Celebrated

✚ The Lord's Supper is Instituted...

✚ Communion is a symbolic display of God's great love and contains lessons for us all.

☆ Observe / Learn / Display

The Lessons from the Table of the Lord Philippians 2:1-11

1. Humility

✚ Lowliness of Mind (See Colossians 1:15-19; 2:9; Hebrews 1:3)

✚ Philippians 2:5-8 – "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus..."



2. Consideration

✚ Consideration of Others
(Luke 22:24-30)

✚ Jesus was focused on
serving the will of God
and rescuing humanity.

✚ Philippians 2:5-8 – He made Himself of no reputation, took on the form of a bondservant, and came in the likeness of men... humbling Himself and becoming obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross!



3. Sacrifice

✚ The Bread speaks of Incarnation...

✚ The Cup speaks of Suffering...

✚ Sacrifice – John 15:12-13; Philippians 2:6-8

✚ John 13:1 – "...having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end."

4. Surrender

✚ Commitment, Dedication, Full Submission

✚ Luke 22:42 – "Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done."

✚ 1 Peter 1:19-20; Hebrews 1:1-5; 10:5-10
