7) Christ's Sacrifice Was ACCEPTED IN HEAVEN.

- ✠ Hebrews 8:1-2, 5 – Christ Is A Minister of the True Sanctuary
- ✠ Hebrews 9:1, 9, 11-12, 23-24 – Christ Is The High Priests of the Greater & More Perfect Tabernacle

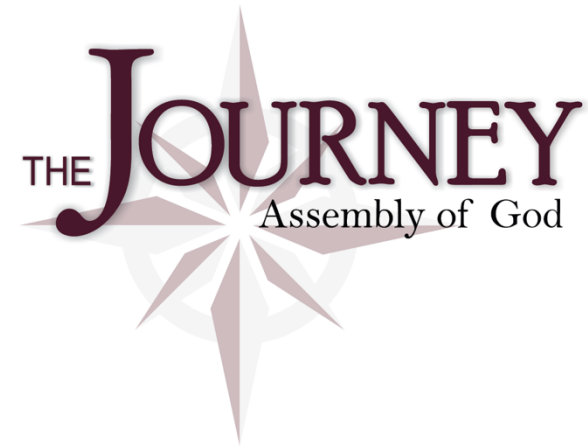
8) Christ's Sacrifice Gained Us ACCESS TO GOD.

- ✠ Matthew 27:50-53 – The Veil of the Temple Torn In Two

THE CONCEPT OF SACRIFICE

- ✘ Without the theme of sacrifice and the ultimate sacrifice of Christ upon the cross – there is no salvation for mankind.

THE CONCEPT OF SACRIFICE & THE DEATH OF JESUS CHRIST

- ✘ The Sacrifices of the Old Testament Covenant are an inferior picture of a **SUPREME SACRIFICE** that was yet to be offered.
 - ✧ The Old Testament is forward looking – a shadow / type / symbol / picture of what was to come. The Death of Christ is the "Supreme Sacrifice" God was looking for and it effectively atoned for the sins of mankind. (1 Timothy 2:5-6 – Jesus is our Mediator with God!)



THE BOOK OF HEBREWS & THE SACRIFICE OF CHRIST

- ✘ The writer to the Hebrews highlights in several ways how the sacrifice of Christ EXCELS the sacrifices of the old covenant. ¹



- 1) Christ's Sacrifice Was The Sacrifice of GOD HIMSELF.
 - ✘ Hebrews 1:1-4 – God's Supreme Sacrifice
 - ✘ Hebrews 2:9-18 – Jesus Tasted Death for Everyone
 - ✘ Hebrews 3:1-6 – The Faithfulness of the Son of God
- 2) Christ's Sacrifice Was The Sacrifice of "THE SUPREME" HIGH PRIEST.
 - ✘ Hebrews 4:14-16 – Our Compassionate High Priest
 - ✘ Hebrews 5:1-11 – The Qualifications of High Priesthood
 - ✘ Hebrews 6:13-20 – God's Infallible Purpose in Christ
 - ✘ Hebrews 7:11-28 – The Need For A Completely New Priesthood
- 3) Christ's Sacrifice Was Offered ONLY ONCE.
 - ✘ Hebrews 7:26-27 – Jesus' One-Time Sacrifice
 - ✘ Hebrews 9:6-7, 11-12, 24-26, 28 / 10:1, 10-12 – **"Once For All"**
- 4) Christ's Sacrifice Initiated A SUPERIOR COVENANT.
 - ✘ 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 – "This is My body which is broken for you... This cup is the new covenant in My blood"
 - ✘ Hebrews 8:1-13 – The Mediator of the New Covenant
 - ✘ Hebrews 11:1-4, 17-19, 27-28, 39-40 – Faith is the Key!
 - ✘ Hebrews 9:1-28 – Jesus Work at Calvary is The Fulfillment of Old Testament Typology
- 5) Christ's Sacrifice Was An Offering of SUPERIOR BLOOD.
 - ✘ Hebrews 10:1-10 – The Insufficiency of the Blood of Bulls & Goats.
 - ✘ Hebrews 10:11-18 – Jesus Offered His Own Blood!

THE BOOK OF HEBREWS & THE SACRIFICE OF CHRIST

- 1) Christ's Sacrifice Was The Sacrifice of GOD HIMSELF.
 - ✘ Read again Hebrews 1:1-4 – How is Jesus God's Supreme Sacrifice of Himself? Consider what Jesus said in John 15:13.
- 2) Christ's Sacrifice Was The Sacrifice of "THE SUPREME" HIGH PRIEST.
 - ✘ Read again Hebrews 4:14-16 – Regarding Jesus as our Compassionate High Priest. How does He relate to us in this way?
- 3) Christ's Sacrifice Was Offered ONLY ONCE.
 - ✘ Hebrews 7:26-27 – Describes Jesus' One-Time Sacrifice as our Great High Priest. What does it say about Him and why is His sacrifice considered sufficient to be "Once And For All"?
- 4) Christ's Sacrifice Initiated A SUPERIOR COVENANT.
 - ✘ What was wrong with the Old Covenant? Why was it inferior and insufficient? (Consider Hebrews 8:7-13 and 10:1-4, 11-18) How is Jesus the Mediator of the New Covenant? (See Hebrews 8:6; 9:11-15; 12:24; 1 Timothy 2:5-6)
- 5) Christ's Sacrifice Was An Offering of SUPERIOR BLOOD.
 - ✘ How can we express our gratitude to God for the shed blood of Jesus? (Review Hebrews 10:1-18 on the insufficiency of animals.)
- 6) Christ's Sacrifice EFFECTED FORGIVENESS.
 - ✘ How did Jesus' sacrifice impact the heart of God and thereby produce forgiveness for our sins? (Read 1 John 2:2 and look up the word "propitiation" to see how this relates to our forgiveness.)
- 7) Christ's Sacrifice Was ACCEPTED IN HEAVEN.
 - ✘ What does Hebrews 9:11-14 say about Christ's activity in heaven?
- 8) Christ's Sacrifice Gained Us ACCESS TO GOD.
 - ✘ According to Hebrews 4:14-16 and 10:19-25 what are we encouraged to do with this newfound access into God's presence?
