
- ✤ See also John 3:8; Luke 4:1-21; 11:18-26.

 - Mark 3:28-29 ~ Blasphemy against the Holy Spirit is unforgiveable!



- ✤ Luke 11:27-32 ~ A Woman Speaks Out: "Blessed is the womb that bore You, and the breasts which nursed you."
 - + Jesus replied: "More than that, blessed are those who hear the Word of God and <u>KEEP</u> it!"

UNPARDONABLI

- ▲ Mark 3:31-35 ~ Jesus' mother and brothers came seeking Him.
 - ✦ Jesus replied: "Who is My mother, or My brothers?" "Whoever DOES the will of God is My brother and My sister and mother."


MY NEXT STEP TODAY IS TO ...

- □ <u>Identify the Friction</u> ~ Are there things in my life that are causing <u>friction</u> between Jesus and me? I need to deal with them.
- □ <u>Consider the Charges</u> ~ Have I ever <u>blamed God</u> for things that I thought were His fault and not fair to me or my family? If so, I need to reconsider!
- Understand the Challenge ~ If God is for me, who can be against me? God's kingdom and purposes are not divided. Don't believe the lies of the devil and blame God for what the devil is distorting and corrupting.
- □ <u>Steer Clear of the Condemnation</u> ~ Avoid the <u>unpardonable sin</u> of blaspheming the Holy Spirit. Be smart. Honor Christ. Respect the Holy Spirit.
- □ <u>Become Part of the Family</u> ~ Make <u>a faith decision</u> and be <u>born again</u> by prayerfully placing my <u>faith</u> in Jesus Christ, God's Son.



FRICTION!

✤ The friction between the scribes and the Pharisees and Jesus is really heating up!



The Setting: Mark 3

- \blacksquare vv.1-6 ~ Jesus heals a man with a withered hand on the Sabbath.
- ♥ vv.7-12 ~ A great multitude followed Him from all over and He healed many, cast out the <u>UNCLEAN</u> spirits!
- ♥ vv.13-19a ~ Jesus went up on a mountain and appointed 12 men to be His disciples. (See also Luke 10:1-17; 11:14-26)
- ✓ vv.19b-21 ~ Jesus went into a house in Capernaum and the multitude came together again, so much that they could not so much as eat <u>BREAD!</u>

♥ His own people said ~ "He is out of His mind!" (v.21) [See also Mark 6:3; Matthew 13:55; John 2:12; 7:5; Psalm 69:8-9]

<u>Message Talk Sheet (Continued...)</u>

1. THE <u>CHARGE</u>: Casting Out Demons By Beelzebub!

 Mark 3:22 ~ The Scribes:
 "He has Beelzebub," and,
 "By the ruler of the demons He casts out demons."



- ✤ Luke 11:14-16 ~ The Actual Event
- $oldsymbol{\Phi}$ So who is this Beelzebub and what exactly were they claiming?
 - $\,\,{\ensuremath{\&}}$ Latin Vulgate: Baalzebub ~ "lord of the flies" OR
 - ♥ Greek Manuscripts: Baalzebul ~ "lord of the dwelling place (temple)" [i.e., prince of evil spirits]

2. THE <u>CHALLENGE</u>: A Kingdom Divided Against Itself Cannot Stand!

- Mark 3:23 ~ Jesus summons His accusers to Himself and refutes their charges in parables.
- ✤ Accusation #2: "Casting Out Demons By Beelzebub"
 - ← Jesus renders it "<u>ABSURD</u>" and "<u>REDICULOUS</u>"
 - + Two Parabolic Illustrations:
 - v.24 ~ A kingdom divided against itself cannot stand.
 v.25 ~ A <u>HOUSE</u> divided against itself cannot stand.
 - v.26 ~ "And if Satan has risen up against himself, and is divided, he cannot stand, but has an end."
- ✤ Accusation #1: "He Has Beelzebub"
 - + Jesus shows that just the **<u>OPPOSITE</u>** is true.
 - v.27 ~ "No one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first <u>binds the strong</u> <u>man</u>. And then he will plunder his house."
