# The Keys of the Kingdom (Continued...)

#### <u>★ Limitations to the Authority of the Church's Power:</u>

- The church does not have authority on its own to invent new standards about what is morally right and wrong, for the authority to define <u>right</u> and <u>wrong</u> belongs to God alone (see Rom. 1:32; 2:16; 3:4–8; 9:20; Ps. 119:89, 142, 160; Matt. 5:18).
- Section 2015 Examples of Abuse:
  - ☆ The Pharisees and religious leaders (See Mark 7:1-13; Matthew 23:1-33)
  - ☆ The Roman Catholic Church and their traditions of penance and indulgences; the Crusades!



### The Power of the CHURCH and the Power of the STATE.

- ★ Should the church ever use physical force (e.g., weapons and armies)
  to carry out its mission?

  "Take up the Sword"
  8
  - Luke 22:35-38 ~ "Lord, look, here are two swords." And He said to them, "It is enough."
  - ➡ John 18:10-11; Luke 22:51-53 ~ "Put your sword into the sheath.

    Shall I not drink the cup which My Father has given Me?"
  - The makeup of Jesus' Kingdom is not currently of this world (John 18:35-37; 2 Corinthians 10:3-4; Ephesians 6:12)

# <u>★ So what about the State, Federal and Civil Government Roles in Exercising Authority & Power?</u>


- Romans 13:1-7 ~ God's gives the civil government the right to bear the sword to restrain and punish evil in our world.
- However, at the same time, there is no indication that the power of government is to be used to enforce adherence to Christianity, or any religion for that matter, upon any people (Luke 9:54-55).
- Exceptions granted to obeying civil government: Exodus 1:15-22; Daniel 3:1-30; 6:1-28; Acts 4:1-31; 5:12-29.


### Our Privilege: The Study of God's Word

♣ The Bible in America is a massive industry (\$2.5 billion) yet it is the best seller few read and [even] fewer understand. ¹



- Of over 2 billion Christians in the world, less than 30% will ever read through the entire Bible.
- Over 82% of Christian Americans only read their Bibles on Sundays while in church.
- In recent studies, the Pew research indicates that only 25% of Americans now attend church any given Sunday, significantly down from 47% in 1990.
- In the American Bible Society's 2022 report it showed the number of Bible users had dropped nearly 26 million in the previous year.

  That's a drop of ten points to an unprecedented low of 39%—and remained the same in 2023. 4



- ♣ A Few Questions We're Seeking to Answer:
  - Does the Church have any power? And if so, what kind of power? And how much power does she have?
