

Some *GUIDELINES* For the Ministry of the Spiritual Gifts.

1. We all have <u>different functions</u> in the body of Christ and must understand the relationship to the whole body.



- 2. Gifts are to <u>edify all</u>, not just the individual (1 Cor. 14:12).
- 3. One must have no sense of <u>superiority</u> or <u>inferiority</u>, for every member is equally important.
- 4. The gifts are <u>given to us</u>, we do not attain them. God's will and sovereignty determine the distribution of the gifts.
- 5. At the same time, these are <u>God-given manifestations</u>, not human talents.
- 6. Though we may exercise a gift to its fullest, **apart from love**, such exercise is **futile** (1 Corinthians 13:1-3).
- 7. God must have <u>all</u> the glory. ¹

<u>REGULATING the Ministry</u> of the Spiritual Gifts.

- ✤ The idea of regulation has to do with controlling, guiding, supervising, and maintaining something so that it <u>operates properly</u>.
 - Ephesians 4:11-12 ~ God's gifts to the church for edification and regulation.
- ✤ The Gift of Tongues is <u>Valued</u> <u>For...</u>
 - 1. Worship (1 Corinthians 14:2)
 - 2. For self-edification (1 Corinthians 14:4)
 - 3. For praying (1 Corinthians 14:14)
 - 4. For giving thanks (1 Corinthians 14:16-17)
 - 5. As a sign to the unbeliever (1 Corinthians 14:22) 2
