 - (a) **to confess, declare, admit** ~ John 1:20
 - (b) **to confess by way of admitting oneself guilty** of what one is accused of, the result of inward conviction ~ 1 John 1:9
 - (c) **to declare openly by way of speaking out freely**, such confession being the effect of deep conviction of **facts** ~ Matthew 7:23; 10:32-33 ²
- ✘ The power of confession is **liberating!**
