Divine Guidance Is Given To Philip the Evangelist

- Acts 8:26 "Now an angel of the Lord spoke to Philip, saying, "Arise and go toward the south along the road which goes down from Jerusalem to Gaza." This is desert.
- Much of God's divine guidance relates to the Great Commission:
 - \$ Acts 5:20 / Acts 10 / Acts 16:6-10 / Acts 18:5-11 / Acts 23:11
 - ♥ Philip was being guided to a remote & desolate location.
 - ♦ The South: "Noon"
 - ♦ Desert: "Uninhabited"
 - ♥ Rise Up: "Prompt Action"
 - ♥ Faith: "Abraham's Journey" (Hebrews 11:8)



God's Timing & Divine Guidance Is Impeccable!

- <u>Modedience</u>: Acts 8:27a "So he arose and went."
- <u>A Divine Encounter</u>: With The Ethiopian Eunuch! (Acts 8:27b-28a)
 - ^{27b} "And behold, a man of Ethiopia, a eunuch of great authority under Candace the queen of the Ethiopians, who had charge of all her treasury, and had come to Jerusalem to worship, ^{28a} was returning."



- ₱ Providential Guidance: The eunuch was reading the scroll of Isaiah! (Acts
 8:28b "And sitting in his chariot, he was reading Isaiah the prophet.")
- ★ Further Guidance: Acts 8:29-30a ²⁹ "Then the Spirit said to Philip, 'Go near and overtake this chariot.' ³⁰ So Philip ran to him, and heard him reading the prophet Isaiah…"
- **▼** Some Critical Questions:
 - Acts 8:30b Philip: "Do you understand what you are reading?"
 - ♦ Acts 8:31a Eunuch: "How can I, unless someone guides me?"
- <u>An Incredible Invitation</u>: Acts 8:31b − "And he asked Philip to come up and sit with him."
- ▲ A Providential Text: Isaiah 53:7-8
 - Acts 8:32-33 The place in the Scripture which he read was this:

"He was led as a sheep to the slaughter; And as a lamb before its shearer is silent, So He opened not His mouth.

In His humiliation His justice was taken away, And who will declare His generation? For His life is taken from the earth."



★ Another Critical Question: Acts 8:34 –
So the eunuch answered Philip and said,
"I ask you, of whom does the prophet
say this, of himself or of some other
man?"
