Ministry to Believers (Continued...)

- The public church service is intended to do this (1 Corinthians 14:26), but the <u>individuals</u> are also to build themselves up in the most holy faith (Jude 20) and to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18). ⁵
- Some Practical Ways Edification Can Be Accomplished: Discipleship, Fellowship, Spiritual Correction, Sharing, and Bearing One Another's Burdens.⁶

✤ <u>Purpose #3 – To Purify Itself</u>

This is why Christ gave Himself for the Church (Ephesians 5:25-27).



- ✤ How Does This Work?
 - ☆ There is a purging that <u>The Father</u> performs (John 15:2; Q Corinthians 11:32; Hebrews 12:7-11).
 - There is a purging that <u>The Believer</u> should perform (1 Corinthians 11:28-31; 2 Corinthians 7:1; 1 John 3:2).
 - There is a purging that <u>The Local Church</u> is asked to perform (Acts 5:11; Rom. 16:17; 1 Cor. 5:6-8, 13; 2 Cor. 2:6; 2 Thess. 3:6, 14: Titus 3: 10f.; 2 John 10).⁸





✤ Purpose #1 – Worship

Colossians 3:16; Ephesians 1:5, 12, 14
"To the Praise of His Glory."



- b The Westminster Shorter Catechism: What is the chief end of man?
 - Man's chief end is to <u>Glorify God</u> and to enjoy Him forever (Ecclesiastes 12:13; Romans 15:6, 9; Ephesians 1:5, 12, 14, 18; 3:21; 2 Thessalonians 1:12; 1 Peter 4:11).
- \clubsuit How is God Glorified?
 - We glorify God by worshipping Him (John 4:23f.; cf, Phil. 3:3; Rev. 22:9).
 - ☆ We glorify God by **prayer** and **praise** (Psalm 50:23).
 - ☆ We glorify God by <u>living a godly life</u> (John 15:8; 1 Peter 2:9; cf. Titus 2:10).²
- 🗞 Worship Greek: proskuneö, originally meant 'Kiss toward.' ³
- Every aspect of one's life as a believer should be characterized by the desire to exalt and glorify the Lord (1 Corinthians 10:31).

Ministry to Believers



- The Church's Goal: To Build Believers Up to <u>Maturity</u> in the Faith (Colossians 1:27-29).
- God Gave Gifted Persons To Accomplish This Goal (Ephesians 4:11-16).⁴
 - \Rightarrow To <u>equip the saints</u> for the work of ministry (v.12a).
 - For <u>building up</u> [Edifying / Nurturing] the Body of Christ (v.12b).
 - Until we all attain to the <u>unity of the faith</u> and of the <u>knowledge</u> of the Son of God (v.13a).
 - ☆ To a <u>perfect man</u> [into maturity] (v.13b).
