

Wise Counsel Is Given & Received

✖ Abigail Meets & Confronts David: 1 Samuel 25:19-31

- ↳ She humbles herself before David with her appeal (v.23).
- ↳ She takes responsibility for her husband's iniquity (v.24).
- ↳ She owns the truth about Nabal – He is a scoundrel (v.25a).
- ↳ She confesses her innocence (v.25b).
- ↳ She pleads with David to relent from his wrath (v.26).
- ↳ She presents her gift for David's men & pleads for forgiveness – declaring her faith in God's promises concerning David (vv.27-31).

✖ David Acknowledges Her Gift, Her Character & Her Wisdom: 1 Samuel 25:32-35 – He sees the divine timing in her visit and advice.

The Rest of the Story...

- ✖ Nabal Parties Hard & Perishes: 1 Samuel 25:36-38 – "His heart died within him, and he became like stone" and ultimately dies!
- ✖ David Takes Abigail for His Wife: 1 Samuel 25:39-44 – She responds favorably, with humility and gratefulness!

"Gratitude Prevails"

Feeling Thankful!

- ✖ Thanksgiving is a spirit of gratitude that we can celebrate year-round!
- ✖ 1 Thessalonians 5:18 ~ "In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

Text: 1 Samuel 25:1-44

A Unique Couple – Nabal & Abigail

- ✖ 1 Samuel 25:1 – Samuel and David
- ✖ 1 Samuel 25:2-3 – Nabal: A man of corrupt character!
 - ↳ A rich snob – a scoundrel, a royal jerk, harsh and evil, full of folly and completely unreasonable! (See also vv.17, 25)
- ✖ 1 Samuel 25:3 – Abigail: A woman of noble character!
 - ↳ A wise and discerning person – with a good understanding and a beautiful appearance.
- ✖ Inward character is what truly matters!



Your Character Matters!

- ✖ Your Character: Your character will ultimately shine through in your life (Luke 6:45; Proverbs 4:23).
- ✖ David's Heart & Character: "A man after God's own heart!" (1 Samuel 13:14; Acts 13:22)
 - ↳ He was persistently thankful (See Psalm 9:1; 30:12; 95:1; 138:1)
- ✖ David's Character On Display: 1 Samuel 25:4-9 – He protected Nabal's men and sent greetings of peace to Nabal.
- ✖ Nabal's Character On Display: 1 Samuel 25:10-11 – He scoffed and selfishly rejects David's request and mocks his identity.



The Integrity of Your Character

- ✖ David's Nature: A Warrior!
 - ↳ 1 Samuel 17:34-36 – A shepherd boy experienced in combat.
 - ↳ 1 Samuel 18:7 – A military leaders for King Saul.
 - ↳ 1 Samuel 22:2; 23:8-12 – A fugitive with an elite army of 400 soldiers.
 - ↳ 1 Samuel 25:12-13 – David: "Every man gird on his sword!"
- ✖ The Integrity of Both David & Nabal Was Being Tested: Would Nabal share his wealth? Would David trust in God or take vengeance into his own hands? Was there a lack of gratitude in each of them?
- ✖ Abigail's Character On Display: 1 Samuel 25:14-20 – She responds swiftly, wisely, with understanding, generosity and gratefulness towards David.
 - ↳ v.18 – Then Abigail made haste and took two hundred loaves of bread, two skins of wine, five sheep already dressed, five seahs of roasted grain, one hundred clusters of raisins, and two hundred cakes of figs, and loaded them on donkeys.
- ✖ When gratitude prevails, blessings follow!
