#### Invisible, Yet Visible

➡ <u>INVISIBLE</u>: The church, in its true spiritual nature as the fellowship of all New Testament Believers, <u>is invisible</u>.



- ⋄ It is spiritual in nature.
- The visible Church, like the local church, should be a smaller version of the invisible (or universal) Church. <sup>7</sup>
- Definition: "The invisible church is the church as God sees it." 8
- ▼ <u>VISIBLE</u>: "The visible church includes all who profess faith in Christ in this New Testament Period and give evidence of that faith in their lives." 9
  - Definition: "The visible church is the church as Christians on earth see it."
  - An Important Distinguishment: The Church Invisible composed of real Christians from all denominations; The Church Visible – consisting of all who profess to be Christians. 10
  - ♦ 2 Timothy 2:19 ~ "The Lord knows those who are His."
  - ♦ Avoiding the Extremes: A "Both-And" Approach. 11





▼ The Church is the means by which God is reaching the lost with the Gospel of His love and salvation!





#### Universal. Yet Local

<u>WINIVERSAL</u>: "In the universal sense the church consists of all those who, in this age, have been born of the Spirit of God and have by that same Spirit been baptized into the body of Christ." ⁴



- ♦ 1 Corinthians 12:13 / 1 Peter 1:3; 22-23
- God has given birth to a people that transcend ethnicity, geographical borders, and even generations & centuries of time!
- <u>■ LOCAL</u>: "In the local sense the word 'church' is used of a group of professed believers in any one locality." <sup>5</sup>
  - ⇒ Jerusalem (Acts 8:1; 11:22), Ephesus (Acts 20:17), etc.
  - "Ideally the local church should be <u>a small replica</u> of the Church universal." <sup>6</sup>
