- ₩ Mark 4:24c ~ The Reward: "To you who hear, more will be given."
- Mark 4:25a ~ The Responsibility: To share the truth of the gospel ~ "For whoever has, to him MORE will be given!"
- Mark 4:25b ~ The Accountability: "But whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him."

Matthew Henry ~ "Burying a talent is the betraying of a trust, and [it] amounts to a forfeiture; and gifts and graces rust for want of wearing [or use]."

A Weighty Conclusion:

- God expects us to hear the parables, think carefully about them, and then take <u>ACTION</u> with them.
- ► Mark 4:33-34 ~ ³⁴ "Jesus used many stories like these to teach the crowd God's message—as much as they could understand. ³⁴ He always used stories to teach them. But when he and his followers were alone, Jesus explained everything to them."







- ♥ vv.3-9 ~ The Parable of the Sower
- ▼ vv.10-12 ~ Jesus explains why He used parables.
- ▼ vv.13-20 ~ Jesus explains the meaning of the Parable of the Sower.
- ▼ vv.21-34 ~ Jesus shared several other parables:

 The Parable of the Growing Seed;

 The Mustard Seed; and the Lamp.

1. The Parable of the LAMP.

Mark 4:21 ~ Jesus begins with a question: "Is a lamp brought to be put under a basket or under a bed? Is it not to be set on a lampstand?"



- ★ Lamps were meant to SHINE!
 - ♦ John 8:12; 9:5; 1 Thessalonians 5:5; Philippians 2:15;
 Matthew 5:14-16
- ► Mark 4:22 ~ Jesus taught: "There is nothing hidden which will not be revealed, nor has anything been kept secret but that it should come to light."
 - We were not meant to be put under a bushel or under a bed!
 - We were designed to be set on a **CANDLESTICK!**

2. Think CAREFULLY About What You Hear.

Mark 4:23-24a ~ Jesus challenged His disciples to "Think carefully about what you hear." (NCV)



- ► Here's Why: There is an element of blessing, reward, responsibility, and accountability when it comes to the parables of Jesus!
- ► Mark 4:24b ~ The Blessing: "With the same measure you use, it will be measured to you."
