OBSERVATION & INTERPRETATION

[3] In light of this weekend’s message how does Jesus’s triumphal entry speak to our true citizenship, purpose, authority and ultimate victory in Christ?

APPLICATION

[4] What are you doing to stay hopeful, prayerful, and filled with joy?

[5] How are you using your experiences during these challenging times to grow your faith and increase your joy (see James 1:2-4)?

[6] Is your joy being tested right now? What have you learned from this weekend’s message that will help you stay on track?

[7] What is the difference between a crowd that follows and a follower of Christ? How are you living out your faith in Christ in front of others during these challenging times?
