CONNECTION

- [1] Is respect something that is earned or is it given because each person is made in the image of God? Please explain your thoughts.

OBSERVATION & INTERPRETATION

- [2] What do Genesis 1:26-27, Acts 10:34-35, Acts 17:26-27, and Revelation 7:9-10 (NIV), imply about the nature of humanity and God's establishment of nations and cultures?
- [3] How does being in Christ and His work of salvation change the nature of how we relate to people different from ourselves? See Romans 10:12, Ephesians 2:14-16, Colossians 3:11-12, James 2:8-9(NIV).

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APPLICATION

[4] What does it mean to be a neighbor? How can you love your neighbor as yourself?

[5] What is the connection between loving our neighbor and Godlikeness?
