CONNECTION

[1] What does it mean to be "rich in Christ"? How is this the same or different from how our culture defines being rich?

OBSERVATION & INTERPRETATION

- [2] Is it true that as human beings we have a strong need to be chosen and accepted? Please share your thoughts?
- [3] What consequences have you observed in your own life or people you know when you (they) do not feel accepted and valued?

APPLICATION

- [4] Ephesians 1:4-6 (NKJV) Points out that God the Father purposely chose, adopted, and accepted us before we were even born. How can truly believing this impact our sense of value and acceptance in a world that can often be judgmental and rejecting?
- [5] Ephesians 1:7-12 (NKJV) explains that we are not only forgiven, redeemed from sin, and made part of God's inner circle, we are also given an inheritance as joint heirs with Christ. What did pastor Rich mean when he said, "What you do for the church enhances your inheritance"? How can you apply this concept to your life?
- [6] The gift of the Holy Spirt is a seal and down payment that gives us proof that God will complete the redemption of all things and assures our place with Christ forever. How can knowing this truth keep us focused on Christ and His plan for our life when the world seems to be spinning out of control?

REFLECTION

[7] This weekend's message is a beautiful picture of the grace God has lavished on us through Jesus Christ. If you began to see bringing Him praise as your purpose in life, how would that change things?
