LifeGroup Discussion Guide

CONNECTION

- [1] Samuel (1 Samuel 3:1-10 NKJV) didn't recognize that God was trying to talk with him; what comes to mind when you think of God speaking to you?

OBSERVATION & INTERPRETATION

- [2] What methods or means does God use to speak to people according to this weeks message?
- [3] Are you open to God speaking to you in ways that you haven't experienced before? Please explain.
- [4] God may chose to speak to us through a word of knowledge, wisdom, and potentially through tongues and interpretation of tongues. Have you experienced communication from the Holy Spirit through spiritual gifts? What kinds of questions does this bring up with you?



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APPLICATION

[5] With practice we can learn to hear the “still small voice” or what some people call “leadings” from God when we pray and read the Bible. How does our fast pasted, overbooked, culture impact our ability to hear God speak to us?

[6] What changes do you need to make in order to be still before God?

[7] What role does faith play in hearing God speak to us? How does faith lead to taking action?

[8] “The key is to forget about formulas and gimmicks for hearing from God, and to focus instead on developing the kind of relationship with God that will empower you to hear God speaking regularly” (Whitney Hopler).
If you agree with this statement, what steps can you take to deepen your relationship with God?

REFLECTION

Read Romans 1:8 (NIV). Hearing God speak to us can be challenging if we do not have an understanding of His grace and acceptance through Jesus. Are you struggling with shame or guilt to the point where you are afraid that if you open your heart to hear God speak it will be a harsh condemning voice rather than a loving and accepting one?



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
