### **CONNECTION**

## **OBSERVATION & INTERPRETATION**

### Read 2 Kings 4:1-7

- [2] What role does God play in the provision for this family?
- [3] What steps did the widow take in meeting her needs? How did these steps "activate" the flow of God's favor and provision for the family?

#### **APPLICATION**

- [4] What do we need to focus on to turn the unexpected into an adventure? How can you do this in a current unexpected situation you are dealing with now?
- [5] Have you experienced an "impossible circumstance"? How did you deal with the situation?
- [6] If you are currently experiencing an impossible circumstance, how can you turn what you are experiencing into an opportunity for growth and/or a new direction in life?
- [7] What does it mean to call the unexpected happenings in our life "favor"? Share an example from your own life where you could see God working through something unexpected...

### REFLECTION

[8] Pastor Rich shared about the flow of God's from when we walk under grace. His favor flows through people helping us, in present situations, and by the measure we pour into and give grace to others. In what ways is God's grace apparent in your life right now? How are you pouring into other people with the grace God has given you?
