- [1] What does it mean to be "ALL IN"? Can you give an example of a time in your life when you were ALL IN? Please share your experience...
- [2] What insight, principle or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be most helpful, eye opening or troubling? Please explain.
- [3] In what ways was Jesus and God the Father "ALL IN" for us? How does that impact your desire to be ALL IN for Jesus and his kingdom?
- [4] Read Matthew Chapter 13:44-46. What does the parable of the Hidden Treasure and the Pearl mean to you? In what ways do these parables speak to values? How do values influence what it means to be ALL IN?
- [5] Read 1 Kings 19:19-20. What did Elisha do to make sure he was all in when Elijah called him to be an apprentice? Are there some things you need to let go of to move forward to be all in with God's plan for your life?
- [6] Read Matt 19:29 and Philippians 3:8. What are the rewards of being ALL IN for Jesus?
- [7] Mark Batterson said, "Jesus didn't die to keep us safe. He died to make us dangerous. Faithfulness is not holding the fort. It's storming the gates of hell. The will of God is not an insurance plan. It's a daring plan. The complete surrender of your life to the cause of Christ is not radical. It's normal. It's time to quit living as if the purpose of life is to arrive safely at death."
