- [1] Is there an area of your life that you are seeking God to restore? Please explain.
- [2] What did pastor Rich mean when he said that restoration often has to come from the “internal” before it can be manifested in the “external”? Can you give an example of how this process might work in someone’s life?
- [3] Why is it important for churches to develop and produce End-Times-Next-Generation leaders? What role will they play in bringing God’s restoration of the earth and in building his kingdom?
- [4] What is a “covenant relationship”? Why was it important to the Israelites and for the coming messiah (Jesus)?
- [5] What makes covenant relationship and accountability so important to individual spiritual growth? Why do we “owe our presence” to each other in the church?
- [6] What role does covenant relationship play in our heavenly citizenship and the building of God’s kingdom for New Testament Christians?
- [7] What made Nehemiah emphasize the restoration of worship along with the rebuilding of the city of Jerusalem?
- [8] In the early church (Acts 4) worship was practically expressed through fellowship, biblical teaching, prayer/communion, praise and generosity. How was this more of a Christ-centered lifestyle rather than just singing songs to God on Sunday? What might be the impact of the church in growing the kingdom of God and restoring people’s lives if the more Christians embraced true biblical worship?
