

## Restore Part 2 Nehemiah Chapter 2

## **LifeGroup Discussion Guide**

For the week of 6/12/2022

[1] What insight, principle or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be most helpful, eye opening or troubling? Please explain. [2] What do you struggle with the most: A Doubting Heart, a Distracted Heart or a Divided Heart? What makes this a challenge for you? Do you see any "roots" that might be the cause of your heart issues? [3] What did you learn from this week's message that might help you grow and overcome your heart problem? [4] What would your life look like if you could completely trust in God's provision and that he has your back even while you might not be certain of God's timing for your life situation or restoration? [5] Nehemiah didn't just jump into his restoration project, he sought out God for a plan for success, surveyed the situation and then communicated the plan to those who could come along side and help him. How might you apply this model to a situation in your own life or a problem you have identified in your community? [6] Nehemiah honored the king (respected authority) in his honesty and request to be released to rebuild the wall. Why is it so important to respect authority in fulfilling God's calling on our life as well as interacting with the community we live in? [7] What might be the consequences of "doing it our own way" when working on a restoration project? Have you ever experienced this kind of situation? What happened? What could have been done differently? [8] Have you ever experienced opposition to something you knew was God's will for you? How did you handle the conflict? What might you have done differently based on what you have learned from Nehemiah 1 & 2?

[9] Is there some opposition you need to speak to or sever that is getting in the way of God's restoration or will for

your life? What is you plan of action to overcome your opposition?
