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[2] How has Star Wars impacted our modern culture, beliefs, and technology? If you haven't seen this movie you might notice that most people assume you have...what's that saying about its impact?

[3] Unlike the metaphysical "force" of Star Wars, what do Colossians 1:16-17, Ephesians 3:16-18, Galatians 2:20, Philippians 4:13, and 1 Corinthians 15:57 teach us about the true "force" in the universe—Jesus Christ?

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APPLICATION

- [4] How does Christ's power work in and through Christians? Can you think of a time in your life where you experienced His power? Explain.
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- [5] Pastor Rich discussed how unbelief weakens the "force" while belief strengthens the "force"; which part of his message did you most identify with? Why?
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- [6] The force in Star Wars (light/dark; good/evil) is equal in power and must be balanced to maintain order. The biblical view teaches us that the light has overcome the darkness (John 1:5) and that Satan is a created being (Ezekiel 28:13- 15) already defeated by Jesus (John 12:31). How does knowing this help us "overcome evil with good" (Romans 12:21)?
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[7] In the story of Peter's denial and restoration to leadership Jesus reaffirmed Peter and gave him abundant grace in his weakness. Is there a weakness in your life that has led you to be less than what Jesus has called you to be? Where do you need a touch of God's grace and encouragement?

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
