Big Questions:

How do we live a story worth telling?

Hebrews 12:2, "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the Author and perfecter of our faith."

Daniel 6:4-5, At this, the administrators and the satraps tried to find grounds for charges against Daniel in his conduct of government affairs, but they were unable to do so. They could find no corruption in him, because he was trustworthy and neither corrupt nor negligent. Finally these men said, "We will never find any basis for charges against this man Daniel unless it has something to do with the law of his God."

Daniel 6:10, Now when Daniel learned that the decree had been published, he went home to his upstairs room where the windows opened toward Jerusalem. Three times a day he got down on his knees and prayed, giving thanks to his God, just as he had done before.

Daniel 6:14, "When the king heard this, he was greatly distressed; he was determined to rescue Daniel and made every effort until sundown to save him."

Daniel 6:16, "May your God, whom you serve continually, rescue you!"

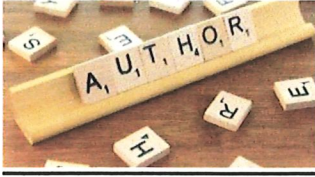

Intentionally Starting Something

1. What does intentional living mean to you?
2. Life goes by much faster than we think it will. If we are not INTENTIONAL with the life we live, one day you might look back and regret a lot of the life you lived. What are some of the typical regrets you hear people talk about?
3. What do you think would change if we lived with the end of our life in mind?
4. How much of life do you think just happens to us? How much of life do you think we can choose to be intentional about?

KEY POINT: The day life really turns a page is when you let God be the author of your story.

5. How many moments which you thought were insignificant really had a major impact on the direction of your life?
6. Those moments can be for good or sometimes not so good. But we will look back at life and say, "Wow, I can't believe the way that decision impacted my story!" How might we choose differently going forward?

KEY POINTS: The decisions that we made yesterday determine the stories that we'll tell today.

The decisions that we make today will determine the stories that we tell tomorrow.

Life Application

KEY THOUGHT: Daniel prayed three times a day. Why could 119 men find no fault in him? Because at some point in his life Daniel made what others would think was an insignificant and very small decision to START praying three times a day.
