

January 30, 2022 FASTING Basics


Fasting is abstaining from worldly to amplify your spiritual
Matthew 6, "When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show men they are fasting. I tell you the truth, they have received their reward in full. But when you fast out oil on your head and wash your face, so that it will not be obvious to men that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you."
Jesus His followers to fast.
Matthew 4:2, And after fasting forty days and forty night

Fasting is between God and

January 9th 2022 FASTING Basics

KEY POINT: Fasting

is abstaining from worldly cravings to amplify your spiritual connectivity.

READ: Matthew 6:16-18

1. What are a few things you noticed in this passage?

KEY POINT: Jesus expects His followers to fast.

READ: Matthew 4:2

- 2. Have you ever considered doing a long term fast?
- 3. The Old Testament is filled with stories of fasting for a variety of reasons such as; mourning, to humble themselves, for protection from attacks, deliverance from bondage, approaching danger, personal afflictions, grief or loss, consecrating themselves to God, for direction/vision, confessing sin, and interceding in prayer for others.
- **4.** Fasting is also found throughout the New Testament. What are some of the ways we see NT believers fasting?

KEY POINT: Jesus expects His followers to fast, and the list of people and reasons for fasting in the Bible is vast!

- 5. What is our posture and countenance suppose to look like when we fast? Why?
- **6.** Why was Jesus so concerned about motives?
- 7. Jesus wanted to make very clear how TO and how NOT to fast and right here, he is telling us how NOT to fast.

KEY POINT: Fasting reveals wrong motives and resists boastful attitudes.

8. Fasting can reveal our hearts, our attitudes, and motives.

DISCUSS: When we willingly abstain from something to pursue God, God will draw near to us. He will also reveal things in you.

9. Verse 10/17 gives us some good information. What does Jesus tell us?

KEY POINT: Fasting is between God and me

10. Fasting is personal. It is a spiritual discipline between you and God that deepens your personal connection to Him. When we personalize our fast between us and God something amazing happens, do you know what that it?

KEY POINT: God recognizes and rewards me when I fast

- 11. The word reward here is a term that was used in business transactions or commerce. It meant to pay someone their dues or wages earned. So now go back and discuss the reward when one fasts with poor motives.
- 12. However, Jesus said when we fast personally and privately, God will reward you with something far greater and enduring than accolades from man. God will reward you with heavenly and lasting rewards. Can you think of a time this happened for you?
- **13.**Fasting isn't an easy discipline or a fun spiritual discipline or a convenient discipline...Do you think these are the reasons we do not fast regularly?
- **14.** Fasting, when done with the right heart, not only deepens your spiritual connection to God but it also releases rewards from heaven!

KEY POINT: Fasting, when done biblically, deepens your spiritual connection to God and releases rewards from heaven.

There are many ways to Fast, the method is not as important as the reason and heart behind the Fast. It could be breakfast, or lunch or dinner, or maybe technology, TV, or anything that requires time that you could instead spend with God.

Life Application: Is there something in my life where I need God to intervene or clarify?

What can I fast to deepen my spiritual connection to God and invite God to release His heavenly reward?
