Father's Day... Godly Calzone

King James: Proverbs 19:18, Where there is no vision, the people perish. What does this mean to you?

1. When God's vision is not in our work, families, lives, what is the likely outcome?
2. What does that have to do with calzones? Nothing really, but In Hebrew the word was Chazown (Ka-Zone) so, when a Hebrew heard this, he heard: Where there is not a dream, without revelation, without vision their people would perish.
3. What are these dreams, visions, revelations, which are dying?
4. Have you even gone through a season where you felt dead inside, like you were just existing with no real meaning to your life?
5. So, what is Godly Vision?

NIV: Proverbs 19:18, Where there is no revelation, people cast off restraint.

6. What does that mean?

The Message: Proverbs 29:18, If people can't see what God is doing, they stumble all over themselves; But when they attend to what he reveals, they are most blessed.
