Expectation 1: Expect to experience times of poverty (Luke 6:20) and expect times of rich blessings (Luke 6:24). Poverty is a gift from God to keep us dependent on God and to be careful in times of wealth to not forget who is blessing you.

Expectation 2: Expect to experience times of hunger (Luke 6:21) and expect times when you will eat like a king (Luke 6:25). Hunger is a gift from God to cause us to remember our source and to be careful when you are well fed to remember what is the real Bread of Life.

Expectation 3: Expect to experience times of pain (Luke 6:21) and expect times of great joy (Luke 6:25). Pain is a gift from God to cause us to lean into His strength and to be careful in your joy remembering to help others in pain and bear each other's burdens.

Expectation 4: Expect to be hated, ostracized, insulted and scorned for the name of Jesus (Luke 6:22-23) and expect to experience being spoken of well (Luke 6:26). Persecution is a gift from God and a promise for all those who live like Jesus and be careful you don't give the glory to yourself because God shares His glory with no man.
