Chair 1 – Come and See

A disciple is a person _____ and _____ their life to become and live as much like _____ as possible.

John 1:35-39 - John's Disciples Follow Jesus,³⁵The next day John was there again with two of his disciples. ³⁶ When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, "Look, the Lamb of God!" ³⁷ When the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus. ³⁸ Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, "What do you want?" They said, "Rabbi" (which means "Teacher"), "where are you staying?" ³⁹ "Come," he replied, "and you will see." So they went and saw where he was staying, and they spent that day with him. It was about four in the afternoon.

Jesus' first invitation in disciple-making is simply _____.

John 1: 40-51, ⁴⁰Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of the two who heard what John had said and who had followed Jesus. ⁴¹ The first thing Andrew did was to find his brother Simon and tell him, "We have found the Messiah" (that is, the Christ). ⁴² And he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon son of John. You will be called Cephas" (which, when translated, is Peter).⁴³ The next day Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. Finding Philip, he said to him, "Follow me." ⁴⁴ Philip, like Andrew and Peter, was from the town of Bethsaida. ⁴⁵ Philip found Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph." ⁴⁶ "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" Nathanael asked. "Come and see," said Philip.⁴⁷ When Jesus saw Nathanael approaching, he said of him, "Here truly is an Israelite in whom there is no deceit." ⁴⁸ "How do you know me?" Nathanael asked. Jesus answered, "I saw you while you were still under the fig tree before Philip called you." ⁴⁹ Then Nathanael declared, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the king of Israel." ⁵⁰ Jesus said, "You believe because I told you I saw you under the fig tree. You will see greater things than that." ⁵¹ He then added, "Very truly I tell you, you will see 'heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending on' the Son of Man."

The way we change _____ is when we invite people to "come and see" Jesus.

Chair 1 – Come and See

KEY POINT: A disciple is a person training and reorienting their life to become and live as much like Jesus as possible.

1. What have we learned about the person represented by chair one?
2. When we are broken, we often look for solutions to our problems. We search for what will truly fill us. We seek answers. Have you ever been in this place? Did anyone suggest Jesus as an answer?
3. Have you ever suggested Jesus as an answer?
4. Why are we so hesitant to share the good news of Jesus with others?

READ: John 1:35-39

5. This is the beginning of Jesus' ministry. What is unique about John in this passage?
6. John wanted to build God's Kingdom not his own. What are some key points we can learn from John?
7. Jesus' first invitation is so simple....

KEY POINT: Jesus' first invitation in disciple-making is simply come and see.

8. This is something we can all memorize and say, why don't we do this more often or at all?

KEY QUESTIONS: Want to come to church with me? Want to join a small group with me? Want to come to Bible study with me?

READ: John 1:40-42

9. How much did Andrew *know* about Jesus? So, knowing the Bible inside and out apparently is not required, to invite people, right?
10. What happened in these three verses?
11. How many of you would say Peter was a very important person in church history?
12. What if John had said, "I cannot let go of one of my most talented disciples?" What if Andrew hadn't shared what he just found?

13. A Quote from Pastor Adam... Andrew was fearless because he found Jesus, so he wanted his brother to as well! He didn't live in fear of what his brother would say! He didn't live in fear of what his friends would say! He found Jesus! So, how could he not go tell people about Jesus? Because John was not afraid to let Andrew go and because Andrew was not afraid to go tell his brother, Simon was transformed by Jesus into Peter. Peter became the ONE person who Jesus said He would build His church upon. And all this started because 1 disciple-maker, found a person, who found a person, who found Jesus! You don't need a PhD in theology to love people where you live.

14. What's one way you can express love to the people around you? How can you help one person connect to Jesus?

READ: John 1:43-51

15. What is the first thing we see happening here?
16. How many of us have just as much passion to tell others about Jesus? How many are inviting people to come to church with them?

KEY POINT: The way we change our town, neighborhood, etc., is when we invite people to come and see Jesus.

KEY QUESTION: Could we, in just 3-4 years, create a movement of disciple-makers, just like Jesus did?

READ: John 14:12

17. So, it is possible right? How different would our community look if we really went after doing what Jesus did again?

Life Application:

Write down some people you know who aren't "church people" or "Jesus people," but maybe could be if you invited them to "come see" more about Jesus.
