Matthew 28: 11-15, The Guards' Report, ¹¹ While the women were on their way, (mom add a title slide after this so they do not go ahead on me)

Matthew 27: 62-66, The Guard at the Tomb, ⁶² The next day, the one after Preparation Day, the chief priests and the Pharisees went to Pilate. ⁶³ "Sir," they said, "we remember that while he was still alive that deceiver said, 'After three days I will rise again.' ⁶⁴ So give the order for the tomb to be made secure until the third day. Otherwise, his disciples may come and steal the body and tell the people that he has been raised from the dead. This last deception will be worse than the first." ⁶⁵ "Take a guard," Pilate answered. "Go, make the tomb as secure as you know how." ⁶⁶ So they went and made the tomb secure by putting a seal on the stone and posting the guard.

No kind of conversion experience would have invented it. To suggest otherwise is to stop doing history and enter into a fantasy world of our own. A fantasy that would lead to their death...."

¹¹ While the women were on their way, some of the guards went into the city and reported to the chief priests everything that had happened. ¹² When the chief priests had met with the elders and devised a plan, they gave the soldiers a large sum of money, ¹³ telling them, "You are to say, 'His disciples came during the night and stole him away while we were asleep.' ¹⁴ If this report gets to the governor, we will satisfy him and keep you out of trouble." ¹⁵ So the soldiers took the money and did as they were instructed. And this story has been widely circulated among the Jews to this very day.

1. Have you ever asked someone this: [Do you believe that Jesus rose from the dead? Because the evidence is available and substantial. The only question is do you believe the evidence or not.] Why or why not?

KEY INFORMATION: If you study the resurrection of Jesus outside of the Bible, you will find few scholars who do not believe that a man named Jesus lived roughly between 2 BC and about 33 AD. 99% of historians believe it is because there are so many historical documents that show that Jesus was not a myth but a real person. Historical evidence for Jesus is excellent.

- 2. Is it possible the reason we don't talk with others about the resurrection is because we don't know enough about it, to discuss it?
- 3. Christianity was widespread in the Roman empire within 80 years of Christ's death. The accounts we can read, are from eyewitness, not just historians looking back years later. Did you know this?

KEY QUESTIONS:

Do you believe Jesus rose from the dead? Do you submit your life to Jesus as the only source of salvation?

- 4. If you answered yes to these questions, do you have any responsibility to those who answer no?
- 5. We are each compelled to decide whether we believe Jesus is truly alive and to live our lives accordingly. What does that statement mean to you?

READ: Matthew 27: 62-66 & 28: 11-15

6. Can you imagine being one of these guards? Imagine walking to the city having to explain this? So, does it make any sense that this was made up by them?



A Quote from Pastor Adam... The Apostle Paul, when speaking about the resurrection said, "You go ask any of these people. They can verify this." Why? Because there were so many witnesses. These are not just people who were claiming to have seen Jesus. These are people that are losing their lives because they're claiming to have seen Jesus. This was people willing to have their wives and children killed to make this claim. A famous theologian Pascal said, "I believe the witnesses that get their throats cut." N.T. Wright said this, "The early Christians did not invent the empty tomb and the meetings or sightings of the risen Jesus. Nobody was expecting this kind of thing. No kind of conversion experience would have invented it. To suggest otherwise is to stop doing history and enter into a fantasy world of our own. A fantasy that would lead to their death...."

- **8.** Did you realize the Jewish leaders paid off the soldiers to lie about what happened?

What do you think actually happened? What is your explanation? How would you tell someone else these facts in history?
