Matthew 28:18-20, The Great Commission, Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make **disciples** of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." **Disciple**: a personal follower of Jesus during his life, especially one of the twelve Apostles.

What is a disciple?

1. What is the mission statement of our church? Why did our church choose this mission statement?

READ: Matthew 28:18-20

- 2. Before the title 'Christian' was widely accepted, the early followers of Jesus were simply called "disciples."
- 3. What is a disciple?

KEY DEFINITION: A disciple is a person becoming like and living for Jesus.

- 5. What would my life look like if training to become like and live for Jesus was my #1 priority?
- 6. What would my life look like if I changed my life to become like and live for Jesus?
- 7. Following Jesus isn't easy! However, becoming more like, and living like Jesus is the best life you can live! How does this work itself out in your life?

READ: Matthew 28: 16-20

8. There are 4 specific instructions in this passage for Jesus' multiplying disciple-maker process:

The first two:

Step 1: Go

Step 2: Make disciples

- 9. How did Jesus model this for us throughout
- 10. Jesus began calling people to follow him and become his Disciples, then what did He
- 11. What is the main directive here; to GO, or MAKE?
- 12. What does it take to "MAKE" anything?

A Quote from Pastor Adam...When you decide to take on an apprentice, or a disciple, you are going to give up a significant amount of time to teach a person your trade. You teach them, let them fail to learn, praise them as they grow,

you do life with them. So, when you read, go and make disciples, this is what it means. The most precious thing we have is our time; so, what bigger act of service is there than to devote your life to others in such a way that other people become fully devoted followers of Jesus? And that is what Jesus is calling every follower of Him to do to this day! 13. So, the obvious question is how many

disciples have you made?

14. Look at the next two instructions in this passage:

Step 3: Baptize your disciples Step 4: Teach your disciples

How do you feel about these two commands? 15. Can pastors do it all by themselves? Could they disciple every single human? 16. Responsibility for discipling is clearly EVERY Christians, read the last sentence in the passage again. Who will be right in the

trenches with us as we disciple? **KEY POINT: Jesus guides us in disciple** making.

17. How do we begin the process?

KEY POINTS: You CAN follow Jesus! You CAN make disciples of Jesus!

18. Do you believe BOTH of these key points?
