1. Did you realize there is far less evidence that Socrates was a real person than there is evidence that Jesus rose from the dead? There is not one known document in the world that he wrote. Yet, we teach about him in school. There are monuments made in his likeness. There is less historical evidence of Socrates existence then of Jesus raising from the dead! Discuss this.

READ Acts 1:1-11, Optional reading (Luke 24: 44-53, Mark 16:19-20.)

- 2. This passage gives us a lot of information, what are some of the noteworthy things we learn?
- Luke gives us many convincing proofs. Not theories. Not Ghost stories. Not legends. Not stories passed down through the generations. Name a few.
- 4. Jesus gives them this promise that He will send them the Holy Spirit, His Spirit, God's Spirit and that they will be baptized in some way, in God's Spirit. But what is their focus on? Why?
- 5. Right now, we are living in a politically charged time and so it was in Jesus' time. What is the problem with looking for a political figure to fix things?
- 6. What can we learn straight from Jesus in verse 7?
- 7. Jesus says stop with your agenda stuff!
 Trust God's timing. Why is this so difficult?

KEY POINT: Life is not about my agenda. I need to make my life about God's agenda.

- 8. Far too often we want it to be all about what we want and not what God is offering us in this moment. What do you get caught up in? Politics, sports, school, college, career, wealth, fitness, having things your way, legalism, culture?
- 9. Our life needs to be focused on Jesus' mission for us. How can we keep our focus on Him?
- 10. What do you believe about the Holy Spirit?

A Quote from Pastor Adam... Jesus is saying, wait for the power of God to come upon you, wait on this mysterious power. But once this mysterious Holy Spirit comes. Then in that moment Jesus charges them to DO something! Jesus instructs his followers to witness in Jerusalem. Jesus is calling you to reach out to people to be a witness for him in your own town! Jerusalem is where they lived, so God is saying it is important to reach those in your everyday life.

READ: the above quote, how are you doing at witnessing in your hometown?

- 11. Next Jesus says now Judea. So, God is saying it is important to reach those outside your everyday life. Jesus instructs his followers to witness in Judea. Where is there a group of people or place you could be a witness to that is outside of your daily life, but that is not to hard to reach out to?
- 12. Next Jesus says witness in Samaria which was a very different culture. Who is this for you?
- 13. Lastly, Jesus says go witness to the ends of the earth, so God is saying it is important to reach everyone on the planet for Jesus.
- 14. Verse 8 tells us how this will happen. What does it say?
- 15. Pastor Adam had us put our name in this verse. But understand this; You and I are powerless without the Holy Spirit. If the Spirit of God does not reside in you... you will not be successful, which is why Jesus said wait and then go and do! How are you doing at following that call?

Life Application

Take some time to pray about who God wants you to be a witness to in ALL those areas.

Ask God to send you the Holy Spirit to empower you in witnessing to those groups, or people, at some point in your life.
