March 13th 2022 World-Changing Leadership

KEY: God incredibly changed Nehemiah's world, His people's world, and His church's world in just 52 days. Why is this important?

- 1. If you take to heart this KEY, God could have you in a VERY different place before the end of April! Discuss that!
- 2. Last week, the sermon goal was to inspire you to think about what burden God has placed on you personally. Have you given this prayer and thought?
- **3.** This week, the sermon was meant to equip and empower you toward what God is calling YOU to do!

KEY POINT: God more often works through your passion, not your position.

4. Where is your heart and passion? What are you doing about it?

KEY POINT: To change our world, you don't have to be the best leader, you just have to care the most.

- 5. God is looking for those who say, "Somebody has got to do something about this, it might as well be me." Can you think of a time you have done this?
- 6. Would say you think you could be a worldchanging leader? God specializes in using ordinary broken people. So, why not you?

READ: Nehemiah 2: 4-10

7. In Nehemiah we can find 4 steps to become a world-changing leader:

STEPS ONE:

1. Define your mission clearly.

REMEMBER THIS: If prayer is not necessary for you to fulfill your mission, you are not thinking big enough.

8. If you can't define it, you WON'T do it.
Define the vision clearly. If you can't define it, you cannot do it. This is practical and if you would do this in ANY area of your life it will be life-changing. Discuss how we can see this in the passage we read.

STEP TWO:

2. Make a detailed plan.

KEY POINT: Failing to plan, is planning to fail. 9. Discuss some of the details you see in the

STEP THREE:

3. Define the first step and do it.

10. This sounds simple but, how often do you have a great idea but never take that first step? Nehemiah simply takes the first step...he goes.

STEP FOUR:
