John 1:35-39, The next day John was there again with two of his disciples. When he saw Jesus passing by, he said, "Look, the Lamb of God!" When the two disciples heard him say this, they followed Jesus. Turning around, Jesus saw them following and asked, "What do you want?" They said, "Rabbi" (which means "Teacher"), "where are you staying?" "Come," he replied, "and you will see."

John 1:43, The next day Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. Finding Philip, he said to him, "Follow me."

Matthew 4: 18-22, As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people." At once they left their nets and followed him. Going on from there, he saw two other brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John. They were in a boat with their father Zebedee, preparing their nets. Jesus called them, and immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.

John 15: 14-16, You are my friends if you do what I command. I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you.

Multiplying Disciple-Makers---4 Chairs

KEY REMINDER: A disciple is a person becoming like and <u>living</u> for Jesus.

1. These chairs represent four stages:



Four stages of becoming a disciple of Jesus.

- 2. The 1st chair stands for a person who does not know Jesus. They are a seeker. How would you describe a seeker?
- 3. Why is the first chair broken?
- 4. What are some of the ways people try to 'fix' their brokenness?

KEY POINT: The Bible teaches us that the ONLY solution to that brokenness is a REAL relationship with Jesus.

5. Why do we tend to run from God? But run to the ways of the world?

READ: John 1:35-39

- Chair one is as simple as, 'come and see' more about Jesus. Some take this step toward God. But remain in chair one.
- 7. Others make the choice to give their life to Jesus as the only source of salvation. Those people step into chair 2. Why is Chair two an infant chair?
- 8. How can we help these new Christians connect to the family of God?

KEY POINT: Just like an infant, this person is learning all kinds of NEW things!

9. What are some of the things they need help in learning?

READ: John 1:43

Chair two is when Jesus went and FOUND Philip....and said "follow me"

A Quote from Pastor Adam... Then we get to Chair 3. This is the chair where people move from learning more about God, Jesus, Holy Spirit and are moved into action. These are people serving inside and outside the church. These are the people who have learned being a Christian, or disciple, it not just about consuming great teaching, worship or fellowship. No, this person has learned it is about serving others and giving. This person is learning how to lead people to Jesus and using their gifts for Jesus. This person is training HARD and is active in the life of the church family.

READ: Matthew 4:18-22

10. How did Jesus Model Chair three in this passage?

READ: John 15:14-16

These are the people who are trained up, working hard, serving like nobody's business, but also leading people to Jesus. This is the person who is out bearing fruit. This is a person who is listening to Holy Spirit and leading people to Christ. This person is teaching their friends, family, neighbors, and co-workers how to follow Jesus. This person is a parent or grandparent in the faith. This person is in Chair 4.

- 12. Who are you discipling?
- 13. Who are you learning from?
