Volunteer Opportunities

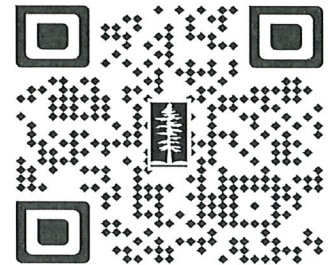

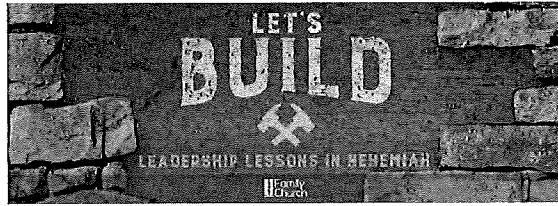
Women's Ministry

God incredibly changed _____ world, His _____ world, His _____ world in just 52 days.

Nehemiah 1:1-4, the words of Nehemiah son of Hakaliah: In the month of Kislev in the twentieth year, while I was in the citadel of Susa, ² Hanani, one of my brothers, came from Judah with some other men, and I questioned them about the Jewish remnant that had survived the exile, and also about Jerusalem.³ They said to me, "Those who survived the exile and are back in the province are in great trouble and disgrace. The wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its gates have been burned with fire." ⁴ When I heard these things, I sat down and wept. For some days I mourned and fasted and prayed before the God of heaven.

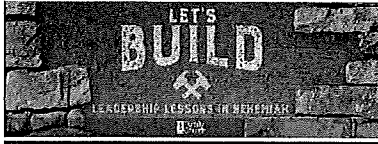
3. A person who _____ God MORE than they fear _____.

Nehemiah 2:1-10, In the month of Nisan in the twentieth year of King Artaxerxes, when wine was brought for him, I took the wine and gave it to the king. I had not been sad in his presence before, ² so the king asked me, "Why does your face look so sad when you are not ill? This can be nothing but sadness of heart." I was very much afraid, ³ but I said to the king, "May the king live forever! Why should my face not look sad when the city where my ancestors are buried lies in ruins, and its gates have been destroyed by fire?" ⁴ The king said to me, "What is it you want?" Then I prayed to the God of heaven, ⁵ and I answered the king, "If it pleases the king and if your servant has found favor in his sight, let him send me to the city in Judah where my ancestors are buried so that I can rebuild it."

Three Steps to Extra-Ordinary Leadership

1. Nehemiah was just an ordinary guy who heard about something happening in his homeland and it bothered him deeply. Do you ever feel burdened by something going on in our country? Have you ever wondered if you could make a difference in our world?

KEY POINT: God incredibly changed Nehemiah's world, His people's world, His church's world in just 52 days.

2. As you think about the sermon we heard, are you willing to say, "Jesus stop sending us more people?"
3. Pastor Adam said, his big dream or task that he thinks God has placed before him and one impossible for him to do, but possible for God to do, is to continue growing our church to reach the lost. Does this match your heart? Do you truly have a heart for the lost?

READ: Nehemiah 1:1-4

4. What are the basics we learn in these 4 verses?
5. God's people were behaving the opposite of what HE expected of them. So, they had been experiencing consequences for disobedience for 140 years and were distraught. Consider where we as a 'Christian nation.' Are we distraught? Should we be?
6. Nehemiah, a regular guy, decided to do something, he had a 'Popeye' moment. God, then and now, uses ordinary world changers like us. What marks an "ordinary world changer?"

World Changer Are: People who will allow God to move their hearts.

7. What does that mean for you?

KEY QUESTION: What breaks your heart on behalf of God?

8. Do you say, "God use me because this thing that breaks YOUR heart, is breaking my heart?"

KEY POINT: Don't ignore what burdens you. Open your heart and see where God takes you.

9. When you say, "Somebody has got to do something, it might as well be me!" Who will God use?

KEY POINT: God uses those who will allow their hearts to be stirred!

10. Read verse 4 again. What is another mark an "ordinary world changer?"

World Changers Are: People who seeks God's direction.

11. Would you consider yourself to be a prayer warrior? God plus one is always a majority! Every battle is won on our knees. Do you believe this?
12. When God gives you a burden to do something do you listen and follow through? Why is follow through a mark of an "ordinary world changer?"

World Changers Are: People who trust God MORE than they fear failure.

READ: Nehemiah 2: 1-10

13. Why was he afraid? What does he do to conquer his fear?
14. At Family Church we have reached over 200 people who have given their lives to Jesus since 2017. How many more could we reach if we expand? How many more could we reach with additional campuses?
15. We have hundreds of kids and students here every week and our goals are that they would ALL grow up to become FULLY devoted followers of Jesus. But we need more room to do that. Do you see the issue at hand? What could we, as a small group, do to be a part of the solution?

Life Application

Take time this week to pray and ask God what burden He wants you to seek His direction on, for you to be a change agent for Him.
